 - ...through the Feasts of Israel,
 - ...the 'Messianic' Psalms
 - ...and through the Old Testament prophets


- Specifically, the Feast of Passover foreshadows Christ's sacrificial death
- The Feast of Unleavened Bread, His burial
- The Feast of Firstfruits, His resurrection

- Jesus' ministry was centred on this one week in history
- Jesus came to do the will of His Father, to give His life as a ransom for many
- Jesus did not want to be made know throughout His incredible 3 ½ years of ministry until one specific day...
- But on that day (Palm Sunday) He intentionally arranges the whole event!
 - Sending disciples to get a donkey etc.
 - Riding into Jerusalem as a king...
 - Much to the distain of the Jewish leaders!

- So what was so special about this day?
- Why did Jesus say 'His hour had now come'?
- Why did Jesus allow Himself to be worshipped as 'Messiah the Prince' on this day (and only on this day)?
- Why did Jesus rebuke the Jews for not knowing what day this was?
- What was so important that Jesus pronounces national blindness upon Israel because they missed 'the time of their visitation' (Luke 19:44)
 - Blindness that has now lasted 1900 years!

- The answer is found way back in the book of Daniel – around 537 B.C.
- Israel's 70 captivity in Babylon was over
- Around 50,000 Jews had returned home...
- ...but Daniel now aged c.83 had remained in Babylon
- Chapter 9 reveals that Daniel was confused:
 - The captivity was over, but Jerusalem still lay in ruins
 - Daniel turned to the prophecies of Jeremiah and realised that there was a second period of 70 years judgment decreed upon Jerusalem

- Daniel then set his heart to pray
 - One of the most impassioned prayers in scripture!
 - Quoting almost verbatim Solomon's prayer in 1 Chronicles 6:36-39
- 1) Confessing the sins of his people (v1-15)
- 2) Interceding for the city (v16-19)
- But part way into his prayer for Jerusalem Daniel is interrupted!
- Not by a knock at the door...
- But by a visitation from the Angel Gabriel!


The First 483 Years

360 Day Year?

- Ancient calendars based on 360 day years
 - Assyrians, Chaldeans, Egyptians, Hebrews, Persians, Greeks, Phoenicians, Chinese, Mayans, Hindus, Carthaginians, Etruscans, Teutons, et al.
- 360° in a circle, 60 minutes/hour, 60 sec/min
- 360 icons in the gnostic genii
- 360 gods in theology of Greek Orpheus
- 360 idols in the palace of Dairi in Japan
- 360 statues surrounding Hobal in Arabia

360 Day Year?

"...all nations, before the just length of the solar year was known, reckoned months by the course of the moon, and years by the return of winter and summer, spring and autumn; and in making calendars for their festivals, they reckoned thirty days to a lunar month, and twelve lunar months to a year, taking the nearest round numbers, whence came the division of the ecliptic into 360 degrees."

Sir Isaac Newton

- 483 years x 360 days per year
- Prophetic years always reckoned as 360 days in Scripture

The Feast of Passover

(Summary)

- Take a lamb on the 10th day of the 1st month
 (March/April)
- The lamb must be perfect
- On the 14th day of the 1st month they were to kill the lamb in the evening
- The blood of the lamb was to be put on the doorposts & lintel – all who passed 'under the blood' into the house would be safe from God's judgment upon the firstborn of the land

No Contradiction

- John, Luke & Mark all refer to the feast (festival) of unleavened bread (beginning on the 15th) as the Passover
 - Mark 14:1
 - Luke 22:1
 - John 13:1

"In the same way that the Feast of Weeks came to be commonly designated Pentecost, the feast of Unleavened Bread was popularly called the Passover. That title was common to the supper and the feast, and included both; but the intelligent Jew would never confound the two; and if he spoke emphatically of the feast of the Passover, he would thereby mark the festival to the exclusion of the supper."





Kangaroo Court

A kangaroo court refers to a sham legal proceeding or court that deny due process rights in the name of expediency. Such rights include the right to summon witnesses, the right of cross-examination, the right not to incriminate oneself, the right not to be tried on secret evidence, the right to control one's own defense, the right to exclude evidence that is improperly obtained, irrelevant or inherently inadmissible, e.g., hearsay, the right to exclude judges or jurors on the grounds of partiality or conflict of interest, and the right of appeal. The outcome of a trial by "kangaroo court" is essentially determined in advance, usually for the purpose of providing a conviction, either by going through the motions of manipulated procedure or by allowing no defense at all.

Kangaroo Court

- 59 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;
- 60 But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none.

Kangaroo Court

- Jesus endured 3 Jewish / 3 Roman trials
- It was illegal to carry weapons on feast a day
- It was illegal to bind the accused before condemnation
- It was illegal for the judges to participate in the arrest of the accused
- No trial could be conducted at night
- Verdict (other than acquittal) could not be pronounced the same day
- High Priest not allowed to rent robes

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- 29 And when they had platted a crown of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews!
- 30 And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.



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

Topology of Mount Moriah








