## Apostasy

- He has been saying that we must imitate Christ in submitting to God's will
- We must also be prepared to suffer for 'doing the right thing'
- He now concludes by saying:
wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to bimin well doing, as unto a faitbful Creator.
- We are but pilgrims, passing through. Not called to a monastic life, but to go forth in the very world from which we have been delivered, being in it but not of it, declaring everywhere God's offer of salvation through the finished work of His beloved Son.
