

- Peter's argument is that Prophecy gives us just such a measure!

A Prophetic Challenge:

- Think of a person who will be born in the future
 - It must at least 500 years from now
- Now write down where they will be born
 - This must be specific, i.e. the actual town name
- Detail a plot to kill them and how it is foiled
- Record where they will grow up
 - This must be somewhere other than the birthplace
- Write down what people will say of this person
- Record in advance their genealogy
- Write down the actual words they will speak
- Note the reaction to these words
- Write down what they will become known for
- Record how they will die and where they will be buried
 - This must include specific details about their death




- Ezekiel prophesied in Ch 26 that
 Nebuchadnezzar would destroy Tyre
- Many nations would be against Tyre
- Dust scraped to become like bare rock
- Fishermen would spread their nets on the remains of Tyre
- Stones & timber thrown into the sea
- Tyre would never be rebuilt
- Tyre would never be found again

- Three years after this prophecy,
 Nebuchadnezzar came up against Tyre
- After a 13 year siege, Nebuchadnezzar finally broke the gates down, only to find the city almost deserted!
- The people had all fled to an island ½ mile off the cost
- This new Tyre was almost impenetrable




- Alexander the Great was the next antagonist
- In order to take the new Tyre, he build a causeway out from the mainland
- He literally scrapped the remains on the old city into the sea, and left just bare rock
- Upon those rocks, fishermen to this day lay their nets
- Over the next 1600 years, many nations did attack and destroy Tyre, until her final destruction in 1291 during the Crusades



- Floyd Hamilton in the Battle for the Christian Faith states:
- "It is also written, 'thou shalt be built no more'. Other cities destroyed by enemies had been rebuilt; Jerusalem was destroyed many times, but always has risen again from the ruins; what reason was there for saying that Old Tyre might not be rebuilt? But twenty-five centuries ago a Jew in exile over in Babylonia looked into the future at the command of God and wrote the words, 'thou shalt be built no more!"



• The voice of God has spoken and Old Tyre today stands as it has for twenty-five centuries, a bare rock, uninhabited by man! Today anyone who wants to see the site of the old city, can have it pointed out to him along the shore, but there is not a ruin to mark the spot It has been scraped clean and has never been rebuilt!"



"The great freshwater springs of Reselain are at the site of the mainland city of Tyre, and no doubt supplied the city with an abundance of fresh water. These springs are still there and still flow, but their water runs into the sea. The flow of these springs was measured by an engineer, and found to be about 10,000,000 gallons daily. It is still an excellent site for a city and would have fresh water enough for a large modern city, yet it has never been rebuilt. Thus [this prophecy] has stood true for more than 2500 years





- The answer is found way back in the book of Daniel – around 537 B.C.
- Israel's 70 captivity in Babylon was over
- Around 50,000 Jews had returned home...
- ...but Daniel now aged c.83 had remained in Babylon
- Chapter 9 reveals that Daniel was confused:
 - The captivity was over, but Jerusalem still lay in ruins
 - Daniel turned to the prophecies of Jeremiah and realised that there was a second period of 70 years judgment decreed upon Jerusalem

Servitude / Desolations



- Daniel then set his heart to pray
 - One of the most impassioned prayers in scripture!
 - Quoting almost verbatim Solomon's prayer in 1 Chronicles 6:36-39
- 1) Confessing the sins of his people (v1-15)
- 2) Interceding for the city (v16-19)
- But part way into his prayer for Jerusalem Daniel is interrupted!
- Not by a knock at the door...
- But by a visitation from the Angel Gabriel!



360 Day Year?

"...all nations, before the just length of the solar year was known, reckoned months by the course of the moon, and years by the return of winter and summer, spring and autumn; and in making calendars for their festivals, they reckoned thirty days to a lunar month, and twelve lunar months to a year, taking the nearest round numbers, whence came the division of the ecliptic into 360 degrees."

Ezekiel gives us a mathematical prophecy concerning the judgment on the Nation:

- Thou also, son of man, take thee a tile, and lay it before thee, and pourtray upon it the city, even Jerusalem:
- ² And lay siege against it, and build a and cast a mount against it; set the camp also against it, and set battering rams against it round about.

Ezekiel 4:1-6

- Moreover take thou unto thee an iron pan, and set it for a wall of iron between thee and the city: and set thy face against it, and it shall be besieged, and thou shalt lay siege against it. This shall be a sign to the house of Israel.
- 4 Lie thou also upon thy left side, and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel upon it: according to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their iniquity.

- For I have laid upon thee the years of their iniquity, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days: so shalt thou bear the iniquity of the house of Israel.
- And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year.

- Ezekiel prophecies a total of 430 years of judgment against Israel as a Nation
- 70 years are accounted for in Babylon
- We are left with 360 years of judgment unaccounted for.
- However we are given a clue in Leviticus 26...

- 14 But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments;
- And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abbor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, but that ye break my covenant:
- ¹⁶ I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart:

Lev 26:14-18




- This 'seven times more' is repeated four times in this one chapter (v18, 21,24,28)

- So if we apply Leviticus 26 as indicated...


- If we multiply the remaining 360 years x7

Beacon of Hope

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

2 Peter 1:19

- Prophecy will pass away...1 Cor 13:8
- It is a guiding light to bring us home!

- 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.
- For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. 2 Peter 1:20-21
- This is not man's work but God's
- The interpretation is not up to man to decide what he thinks, but is revealed to us through His Spirit!
 - c.f. 1 Cor 2:9 <u>AND</u> 10
