"As a lawyer I have made a prolonged study of the evidence for the events of the first Easter Day. To me the evidence is conclusive, and over and over again in the High Court I have secured the verdict on evidence not nearly so compelling. Inference follows on evidence, and a truthful witness is always artless and distains effect. The Gospel evidence for the resurrection is of this class, and as a lawyer I accept it unreservedly as the testimony of truthful men to facts they were able to substantiate"

"History records that two young men, Gilbert West and Lord Lyttleton, went up to Oxford. They were friends of Dr. Johnson and Alexander Pope, in the swim of society. They were determined to attack the very basis of the Christian faith.

So Lyttleton settled down to prove that Saul of Tarsus was never converted to Christianity, and West to demonstrate that Jesus never rose from the tomb"

"Some time later, they met to discuss their findings. Both were a little sheepish. For they had both come to similar and disturbing conclusions. Lyttleton found, on examination, that Saul of Tarsus did become a radically new man through his conversation to Christianity, and West found that the evidence pointed unmistakably to the fact that Jesus did rise from the dead.

## Abraham

- Abraham 'acted out' the crucifixion and resurrection 2000 years before the event!
- The place he did this was Mt Moriah
- Later this place would be known as Calvary
- Abraham's 'dress rehearsal' was in the exact spot the 'main event' would take place
  - See Genesis 22

## **David**

- David recorded 1000 years in advance the very words Jesus would speak on the Cross...
- ...and declare that Jesus body would not remain in the grave
  - See Psalm 22

## Isaiah


- 700 years before Jesus came, Isaiah records many specific details of Jesus arrest, trial, crucifixion, burial and the specific reason for His death.
- Isaiah also prophesies that the resurrected Messiah will rule the whole earth.
  - See Isaiah 53 / 60-61 / 9:6-7

## **Daniel**


- 500 years before Jesus was born, Daniel records the very day Jesus would enter Jerusalem as king (Palm Sunday)
- He records that the Messiah would be killed for others
- He then records that after His death He will one day return to rule the whole earth!

## C.S. Lewis stated:

"I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept his claim to be God. That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic—on the level with the man who says he is a poached egg—or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God, or else a madman or something worse. You can shut him up for a fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God, but let us not come with any patronising nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to. . . . Now it seems to me obvious that He was neither a lunatic nor a fiend: and consequently, however strange or terrifying or unlikely it may seem, I have to accept the view that He was and is God".

- Josephus tells us that it was 60 ft. high and 30 ft. wide
- It was woven, he says, "as thick as the span of a man's hand"
- Estimated weight was around 5 tons
- Josephus says that horses tied to each side couldn't pull it apart

Matthew 27:51

- This occurs at 3pm, just as the evening sacrifice would be commencing in the Temple
- Many priests would have been officiating
  - Acts confirms that many priests come to faith
- The Talmud records an earthquake in Jerusalem c.40 years before the temple was destroyed,

- And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,
- And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

- It would be impossible to write and circulate this if it did not happen
- If false, this would simply be discredited!

Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

It had been supernaturally dark on the earth for 3 hours

- 57 When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple:

- Some victims of crucifixion would last days
  - The longest recorded was 13 days
  - The shortest was 32 hours
- To fulfil prophecy not a bone of Jesus was broken

# Joseph of Arimathaea

- This man was notably wealthy
- He was held in very high regard
- He is called 'honourable counsellor' Mk 15:43
- Only 14 such men in the history of the nation!
- He & Nichodemus are granted Jesus body
- This very act would cause them to be <u>'excommunicated' and lose their office</u>
- They take Jesus, anoint Him, and put Him in Joseph's tomb



# The Royal Guard

- This "watch", was a royal roman guard made up of 16 highly trained roman soldiers
- Each would have a spear, a short sword, and a dagger,
- Each man also had 5 javelins inside of a curved shield
- Their primary weapon however was a sling
- They were trained to hit a target 70 ft. away
- They were the special forces of their day

# The Royal Guard

- And if a commanding officer came and found just one of those guards asleep all 16 men in the guard would be killed
- So if one fell asleep the other guards would set their tunic on fire!
- In 390 A.D. as Rome was beginning to fall apart, the then Caesar commanded Flavius Viratus Ronitus (historian) to search the archives for military and tactical inspiration
- As a result he reconstructed this elite unit

# The Royal Guard

- The tomb was sealed either with wax/clay
- Ropes would have been put across the stone, with the seal or Rome in the centre
- If anyone broke the seal, the punishment was to be crucified upside down,
- If they couldn't catch you, they would crucify upside down every man, woman and child in your village,
- That tomb was sealed and secure!

# The Inside Story!

- In Israel there were tax collectors who would stay in their office and do the paperwork...
- And others who would go out and about and collect taxes from the public
- Matthew was the latter, called 'publicans'
  - Because they collected from the public,
- As a servant of Rome he would always have had a roman soldier with him
  - With his shield and his spear to signify the authority of Rome,

# The Inside Story!

- Matthew is the only Gospel writer to tell us what happened at the tomb...
- ...that an angel came down, and rolled the stone away,
- ...and what happened in the discussion with Pilate...
- ...and that the soldiers didn't go to Pilate when they fled the tomb, but to the priests,
- ...and that the priests paid the soldiers to keep quiet!

- Now when they were going, behold, some of the watch came into the city, and shewed unto the chief priests all the things that were done.
- 12 And when they were assembled with the elders, and had taken counsel, they gave large money unto the soldiers,

Justin Martyr, in his first apology for the Christians, which was presented to the Emperor Antoninus Pius, in the year A. D., 138, having mentioned the Crucifixion of Jesus and some of its attendant circumstances, says:

"And that these things were so done, you may know from the Acts made in the time of Pontius Pilate."

The learned Tertullian, in his Apology for Christianity, about the year 200, after speaking of our Savior's crucifixion and resurrection, and his appearance to the disciples, who were ordained by him to publish the Gospel over the world, thus proceeds:


"Of all these things relating to Christ, Pilate himself, in his conscience already a Christian, sent an account to Tiberius, then Emperor."

- It is Pilate's report to Emperor Caesar concerning the events of the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus
- He details:
  - What happened regarding the crucifixion
  - The kind of man Jesus was
  - That Jesus had been granted freedom to teach the people
  - That wealthy people didn't like Jesus on account of his support for the poor


- It is Pilate's report to Emperor Caesar concerning the events of the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus
- He details:
  - Miraculous events at the tomb of Jesus
    - That a brilliant light was seen
    - That an angelic being appeared
    - That there was an earthquake
    - That trained Roman guards collapsed in terror
    - And that they actually saw Jesus risen from the dead
    - But that they were then given money to keep quiet



# The Gospel

#### - according to the scriptures -

- In fulfillment of Gabriel's prophecy given to Daniel (ch9), Jesus presented Himself as the Messiah of Israel on the <u>very day</u> foretold over 500 years before!
  - Jesus rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and allowed Himself to be worshipped as the Messiah
  - This was the <u>only</u> day in His ministry He allowed this, and He intentionally arranges the event
  - The Triumphal Entry was on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, the very day the sacrificial lamb's from the fields around Bethlehem were being taken and inspected, ready for the Passover sacrifice

# The Gospel

- according to the scriptures
- The Feast of Passover foreshadows Christ's sacrificial death
  - On the 14th day of the month (Nisan)
  - Jesus was able to both celebrate the Passover with His disciples & become the Passover Lamb, dying on the 14<sup>th</sup> because of Exodus 12:6
    - The lamb's must be killed 'Beyn' 'BETWEEN' the evenings – thus a 24 hour window
  - Paul states that Christ became our Passover
     1 Corinthians 5:7

#### Bethlehem's Sheep

 Josephus records that over 250,000 lambs were sacrificed in the Passover celebrations

- It has been estimated that there would have been 144 priests
- Each killing approximately six lambs a minute...
- ...for around 6 hours!
- Typically from 9am to 3pm
  - The very hours Jesus was on the cross!



# The Gospel

- according to the scriptures
- The Feast of Unleavened Bread, His burial
  - As Jesus body was placed in the tomb it became the 15<sup>th</sup> by the Jewish reckoning
  - "Unless a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit" – John 12:24
