

# The Four Soils

Luke 8:4-15

- A summary of the condition of the human heart
  - **The way side**
    - Rejection (the Devil snatches the seed before it can germinate)
  - **Rocky Soil**
    - Doubt (temptation... 'has God really said?')
  - **Thorny soil**
    - Indifferent (the cares of this life take precedence)
  - **Good soil**
    - Believing (received with faith & produces fruit)
- This is true for unbelievers who hear the gospel
- But it is also true of believers regarding God's promises



# Holy Fire


*“Every now and then we come across a life that is radiant, revealing a richness, a warmth, a triumph that intrigues and challenges us.*

# Holy Fire



# Holy Fire

*“The pattern seems to be self-centeredness, self effort, increasing inner dissatisfaction and outer discouragement, a temptation to give it all up because there is no better way, and then...*

*finding the spirit of God to be their strength, their guide, their confidence and companion - in a word, their life!”*



18 Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.

- What is your hearing like?
- Do you hear His voice?
- Jesus says ‘take heed’ to how you receive (hear) God’s Word
  - what is the quality of the soil in your heart like?
- *“Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer that is made in this place”* – 2 Chron 7:14 #
  - God sets the standard: The type of hearing required is that which results in action!

5 Many, O Lord my God, are thy wonderful works  
which thou hast done,  
and thy thoughts which are to us-ward:  
they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee:  
if I would declare and speak of them,  
they are more than can be numbered.

6 Sacrifice and offering thou didst not desire;

- Are our ears opened yet?
- Are we hearing what God is saying?
