Israel had 70 Sabbaths according to the Law of Moses

- 52 weekly Sabbaths
- 7 days for Passover
- 1 day for the Feast of Pentecost
- 1 day for the Feast of Trumpets
- 1 day for the Feast of Atonement
- 7 days for the Feast of Tabernacles
- 1 day for the 'Eighth day of Assembly'

Israel's Sabbaths were bases on the Lunar calendar

The Appointed Times

(Leviticus 23)

- 1 Feast of Passover
- 2 Feast of Unleavened Bread
- 3 Feast of Firstfruits
- 4 Feast of Weeks (Pentecost)
- 5 Feast of Trumpets
- 6 Feast of Atonement
- 7 Feast of Tabernacles

The Feasts of Israel

- In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's passover.
- 6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.
- In the first day ye shall have an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.
- 8 But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day is an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

The Feasts of Israel

- And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:
- And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

- Passover
 - 14th Nisan
- Feast of Unleavened Bread
 - 15th Nisan
- Feast of Firstfruits
 - the day after the Sabbath after Passover
 - always on a Sunday

³ Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

- ⁵ Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:
- And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.
- And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

The Feast Unleavened Bread

- 4 These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.
- In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's passover.
- 6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.



7 days of unleavened bread

18 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even. 19 Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land. 20 Ye shall eat nothing leavened; in all your habitations shall ye eat unleavened bread.


- The Triumphal Entry
 - On the 10th day of the month (Nisan)
 - Jesus rode into Jerusalem intentionally fulfilling Zechariah 9:9
 - The crowds sang Psalm 118
 - Acknowledging Jesus as their Messiah and King
 - This was the ONLY day in Jesus' ministry He allowed Himself to be worshipped as King
 - It was the exact day as prophesied by Daniel (Gabriel) five centuries before!
 - The Lamb was 'taken' on the 10th day!

- The Feast of Passover foreshadows Christ's sacrificial death
 - On the 14th day of the month (Nisan)
 - Jesus was able to both celebrate the Passover with His disciples & become the Passover Lamb, dying on the 14th because of Exodus 12:6
 - The lamb's must be killed 'Beyn' 'BETWEEN' the evenings – thus a 24 hour window
 - Paul states that Christ became our Passover
 1 Corinthians 5:7

- The Feast of Unleavened Bread, His burial
 - Jesus died at 3pm and His body remined on the cross for a short while before being requested by, and then laid in, Joseph of Arimathea's tomb;
 - Yet because the new day (15th) was about to begin, there was not enough time to properly anoint Jesus' body for burial
 - As Jesus body was placed in the tomb it became the 15th by the Jewish reckoning
 - "Unless a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit" – John 12:24

- The Feast of Firstfruits, His resurrection
 - "when the sabbath[s were] past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him. And very early in the morning the first day of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun" (Mark 16:1-2).
 - On the 17th Jesus rose from the dead on the Feast of Firstfruits
 - Thus becoming "the Firstfruits of all that slept"
 1 Corinthians 15:20

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19 And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Joshua 4:19

- The triumphant day the Children of Israel finally crossed over the Jordan and entered the Promised Land, receiving their future kingdom, was the anniversary in advance of the very same day Jesus entered Jerusalem and was received as Israel's future King!
- For Israel the adulation quickly stopped and they crucified their King.
- But He will return to sit on the throne of David and rule over Israel and the whole earth (Luke 1:32-33).

And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho.

- They celebrated and ate their Passover lamb 'in Gilgal... in the plains of Jericho'.
- Their Passover lamb was killed in a place (Gilgal) synonymous with sacrifice and literally right in full view of their enemy.
- On the future anniversary of the very same day Jesus was offered up as <u>The</u> sacrificial Lamb, also in a place synonymous with sacrifice

And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho.

- They celebrated and ate their Passover lamb in full view of the inhabitants of Jericho
- Jesus likewise triumphed over 'principalities and powers', making a public spectacle of them,
- Forever declaring His victory 'It is finished'!
 - Literally in the Greek: 'Paid in full'! (see Colossians 2:15)

And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the passover, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day.

- This was the 1st day they were ever able to celebrate this Feast!
- Note the 'old corn' / 'parched corn'

12 And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land...

- They ate the old corn on the 15th, and the last time Manna fell (the day it ceased), was the next day, the 16th.
 - If it didn't fall on the 16th it would have been said to have ceased on the 15th.
- Why is this significant? Because it means that the 16th represented the old order of things; from 'tomorrow' everything would be different.

12 And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more; but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.

- From the 17th onwards the exact date of the Feast of Firstfruits in the year of the Resurrection, and the very day of the Resurrection itself, Israel ate the fruit of the Land!
- This was a new beginning for Israel, they were finally back in the Land God had promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and living off its bounty!

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- For us, the 17th, the Feast of Firstfruits, the day of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ marks an awesome new beginning!
- It was also the exact same day that Noah's Ark finally came rest on the Earth again at the end of the flood - signifying a new beginning for mankind!
