The Church of Colosse

What was their secret?

- Their focus
- Because of the reality of the future, that gave purpose to the present
- Their confidence of what is revealed in God's Word of what awaits us

Colossians 1:1-2

- Peace must follow grace
- Not as the world knows (John 14:27)
- Peace = 'absence of conflict'

God's Peace

- Hebrew: *Shalom*
- Root: *La shalem*
 - Pay
 - Fill
 - Fulfill
- *We have peace, because Jesus paid the price, fulfilled the law, & filled us with His Holy Spirit*

³ We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,

⁴ Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints,

⁵ For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

Colossians 1:3-4

- 'For' *Gr. dia lit. Because of...*
- 'Hope' *Gr. elpis lit. Expectation, Confidence*
- 'Laid up' *Gr. Apokeimai lit. Stored away*

⁶ Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth:

Colossians 1:6

- Their confident expectation of what is stored away in Heaven, as revealed in the Word, is motivating them to bring forth good fruit (good works)
- Where does the Word tell us of what awaits?

Laid up in Heaven

19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Matt 6:19-21

Treasure in Heaven

- Is this symbolic treasure?
- Or something tangible?
- You cannot offer a symbolic reward!
- In eternity we will dwell in the new Jerusalem & new earth – not heaven
- When will we receive our 'treasure'?

Heavenly Rewards

⁸ Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

2 John 8

- We can earn a reward
- There are differing levels of reward
- It is a reward for our labour
- It is possible to lose it!

The Fairness of God

¹⁸ For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

1 Peter 3:18

- Note: Christ is just!

The Fairness of God

³ I will proclaim the name of the LORD. Oh, praise the greatness of our God!

⁴ He is the Rock, his works are perfect, and all his ways are just. A faithful God who does no wrong, upright and just is he.

The Fairness of God

¹⁰ For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Hebrews 6:10

- You have not / do not run in vain!

The Fairness of God

¹⁵ Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:58

- Though you may not understand the trials now, nothing you go through for God is wasted or in vain.

The Fairness of God

⁸ You number my wanderings;
Put my tears into Your bottle;
Are they not in Your book?

Psalm 56:8

The Fairness of God

16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

Phil 2:16

- In the 'day of Christ' there will be an assessment of our labour

Heavenly Rewards

¹⁰ Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your **calling and election sure:** for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

¹¹ For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:10-11

- We cannot add to our salvation – Grace
- Our ‘Calling’?
 - invitation: to a feast
- Election?
 - of the act of God's free will by which before the foundation of the world he decreed his blessings to certain persons

'Called unto Good Works'

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:10

- We are to give diligence to good works
- Thereby we might have an abundant entrance into Heaven
- Good works are the evidence of our Salvation – they don't contribute to it!

'Good Works'

17 Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

James 2:17-18

- Saved by Grace alone, through Faith alone, in Christ alone.
- Doing things for the kingdom is the outward sign of an inward change

'Good Works'

¹⁶ All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

¹⁷ That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

2 Tim 3:16-17

Parable of the Talents

14 For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

Parable of the Talents

18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

Parable of the Talents

24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:

25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

Parable of the Talents

27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.

28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

30 And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 25:14-30

Parable of the Talents

- To each is given a measure according to ability
- Those who do the most receive the greater reward
- Those who do little receive less
- Those who bear no fruit demonstrate that they have no place in the kingdom

Day of Reckoning

11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;

13 Every man's **work** shall be made manifest: for **the day** shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's **work** of what sort it is.

1 Corinthians 3:11-15

Day of Reckoning

Two types of material

- Wood, Hay, Stubble
 - All burnt up by fire
 - ‘Sowing to the flesh’ ‘treasure on earth’
- Gold, Silver, Precious Stones
 - All purified through fire
 - ‘Sowing to the Spirit’ ‘treasure in heaven’

Day of Reckoning

14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

1 Corinthians 3:11-15

- We have a choice how we live
- Law of Sowing & Reaping
- We will be rewarded accordingly
- It is not an issue of Salvation

Summary So Far...

- We are called to good works (expected)
- We will be rewarded according to our works
- This has nothing to do with salvation which is entirely by grace

*Our good works are an outward demonstration of the faith we have, and are evidence that we are saved

(Matt 7:20 – by their fruits...)

- Christ returns with the saints

After the Rapture

- when the saints arrive in glory

- Our Sin was 'paid in full' at Calvary

Judgment Seat of Christ

Judgment Seat of Christ

¹² For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to glory on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to answer them which glory in appearance, and not in heart.

¹³ For whether we be beside ourselves, it is to God: or whether we be sober, it is for your cause.

Judgment Seat of Christ

¹⁴ For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
¹⁵ And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

- We will all stand at the Beamer Seat
- We will be rewarded
- What Christ has done is our motivation

Judgment Seat of Christ

2 Cor 5:10 / Rom 14:10

- Award ceremony for the saints
- Sin is not part of the equation
- How we have lived as Christians will be the critical issue
- Our deeds will be judged (good or bad)
- Salvation is assured
- Rewards are not
- Where our treasure has been will be the key

⁸ Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

Heavenly Reward

26 I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air:

27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

- rejected, reprobate, having nothing

20 For ye are our glory and joy.

- The joy of seeing the lost found
- Luke 15:7 – “joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repents”

The Crown of Glory

- ¹ The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed:
- ² Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;
- ³ Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock.
- ⁴ And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

What do we do with our Crowns?

- Spend eternity bragging about how well we've done?

Before the throne...

⁴ And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

Elders:

- From every kindred, tongue, peoples & nation
- 'Redeemed by the blood'
- '24' representative of the whole —

1 Chron 24:1-18 / Rev 21:12-14 / 24 hours

Before the throne...

⁹ And when those beasts give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever,

¹⁰ The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

¹¹ Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

What Happens to the Crowns?

- We are rewarded with crowns
- We will cast our crowns before the throne
- Jesus will receive and wear the crowns we give Him

Significance?

- However great our reward, Jesus will receive the glory
- We will not be able to 'brag' throughout eternity
- Once the crowns are cast down we are all the same – sinners saved by grace
- This is our one opportunity to give something back to Jesus
- Today is our opportunity!

Significance?

- Representative of every time you wanted to quit the race
- Representative of every time you faced temptation
- Representative of every time you had the opportunity to talk to someone about Christ

*"Have you no wish for others to be saved?
Then you are not saved yourself.
Be sure of that." C.H.S.*

Significance?

- Representative of every time you wanted to quit the race

- Representative of your looking for his return

Our Response

- The Crown of Incorruption
 - A disciplined Christian life, no compromise
- The Crown of Life
 - Overcoming temptation
- The Crown of Rejoicing
 - Winning souls for Christ
- The Crown of Glory
 - Faithful in ministry
- The Crown of Righteousness
 - Looking for His coming (Sanctified)

- Our Sanctification – 1 Thes 4:3

- So that which was begun in Eden – God's walk with man – will be for eternity

pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and
increasing in the knowledge of God;
