- The connection between Romans 12 and Romans 13 is clear. If the Christian is not to seek personal vengeance, it does not take away the government's authority to punish wrongdoers.

1. Personal Volition: Free will

- The freedom to choose our own destiny
- This history of this country, from the Magna Carta to Wilberforce to the ‘human rights’ legislation of today acknowledge this
 - *“We hold these truths to be self-evident.”*
 - God didn’t want robots.
 - Volition is a prerequisite to love.

– Between one man & one woman

- Man = head of the household as Christ is the head of the Church

 - Not cultural but Divine!

- Responsibility for authority over the children: *Parents; not the state*
- Teach: respect law and order
- Relationships: otherwise chaos ensues

- Habitual criminals stoned
- Kidnapping: death penalty

Genesis 1-11

- Cities of Refuge -
 - 3 east of the Jordan, 3 west of the Jordan
 - Place of asylum for those accidentally killing someone
 - Those fleeing there were protected by divine decree
 - They were protected from the avenger of blood provided they stay within the city
 - They were to stay until the High Priest died
 - Then they were free to leave

Cities of Refuge

- Was the crucifixion premeditated or manslaughter?
 - “Father forgive them for they know not what they do” – Luke 23:34
- We are guilty of manslaughter
- Where to we flee to?
 - *Where is our refuge?*
- How long do we stay?
- Until the High Priest dies...
- Who is our High Priest?

Capital Punishment

- After the flood, God announced the principles of government: Gen 9:5, 6

And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.

Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.

Genesis 9:5-6

- Note the value God places on human life!

Capital Punishment

- After the flood, God announced the principles of government: **Gen 9:5, 6**
- This “everlasting covenant” with Noah is to endure “while the earth remaineth”
Gen 8:20-9:7
- 1,000 years later, under the Law of Moses, God reaffirmed the governmental duty of punishing murderers with death:

Moreover ye shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which is guilty of death: but he shall be surely put to death. So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it.

Numbers 35:31, 33

Reaping The Whirlwind!

- Dr Chuck Missler noted:
- *“The number of known ‘man-killers’ alive in America outnumber the clergymen, the teachers in our schools, judges and magistrates, and even the policemen on duty”.*
- From our education systems to the inner cities, because we have largely removed punishment for wrongdoing, we are seeing it spiral out of control and are dangerously close to anarchy!

Capital Punishment?

- To claim that it is not “Christian” to execute murderers is to directly deny Paul’s plain word in **Romans 13**, that
 - the magistrate “*beareth not the sword in vain,*”
 - being “*a minister of wrath to him that doeth evil,*” and
 - one of whom evil-doers are commanded to be afraid.

Capital Punishment?

- So, is it a disservice to home and nation to label it '*murder*' which God has *commanded to be done*?
 - i.e. the execution of the shedders of human blood.

Capital Punishment?

- It is a libel on Christian Doctrine to claim that the current *'anti-Capital-punishment'* cry is “Christian.”
 - We might not like it...
 - It may be uncomfortable to our sensibilities
 - But it is not about our ‘feelings’
 - Our guide in all matters of faith, conduct and doctrine is the Word of God!

Capital Punishment?

- Note that the Penitent thief on the cross cried out, “*We suffer the due reward for our deeds!*” - Luke 23:31
 - And he cried out to Jesus, “*Lord, remember me...*”
 - Our Lord’s answer, “*Today thou shalt be with me in Paradise.*”

The Bigger Picture

- This demonstrates the fundamental truth:
 - Government in this world;
salvation in the next.
 - Only the ignorant confuse those two.

Fundamental Institutions

Genesis 1-11

- **First World Leader: Nimrod** Gen 10:8-10
 - Son of Cush (Granson of Ham)
 - Later know as Bar-Cush (Bachus)
 - Cush was the instigator of the Tower of Babel (hence ‘Chaos’ derived from ‘Chush’)
 - The descendants of Cush located around the southern parts of the Nile (“Ethiopia”).

Genesis 1-11

- **First World Leader: Nimrod** Gen 10:8-10
 - Established his capital at Bab-El
= Babylon
 - Astrological Temple Gen 11:1-4 6
 - “Mighty hunter *in defiance of the Lord*”



Civil Responsibilities
Chapter 13

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

Romans 13:1-2

- Higher powers: “governing authorities”
- Note that God is still in control!
- “damnation” = judgment; condemnation, due punishment

Believer's Relationship to Government

- Note the Exception: #
 - Acts 4:18-21
- We must be as wise as serpents but as harmless as doves! So, we must also know the law:
 - Acts 23: 1-5; 11; 28:19
- “Don’t poke the bear!”
 - Don’t go looking for trouble, but don’t hide from it either!

The Exception

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marveled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus.

And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

Acts 4:13-14

But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,

Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it.

But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.

Acts 4:15-17

And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.

For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

Acts 4:18-20

So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done.

Acts 4:21

- They chose to ignore this edict from their governing council.
- If it's a choice between man's rule and God's, we chose God's way every time.
- Remember Daniel, Hananiah, Azariah & Mishael, Polycarp – “We’re not gonna bow”!

Believer's Relationship to Government Today

- We have a different situation, one not addressed in the express terms of the Scripture.
 - Our officials are actually *our employees!*
 - The Bible does not seem to deal directly with the responsibilities of a democracy in which officials are elected and laws are drafted by elected officials. We have 'authority' over the officials.
 - *We are committed to the rule of law, not a specific ruler.*
 - Submission in our country is primarily to laws and democratic processes and not to persons.

Believer's Relationship to Government

- Biblical submission calls for a readiness *to obey law and uphold the legal order*,
 - Not an approval or endorsement of all lawmakers or even all laws absolutely.
- Christ's absolute supremacy over our lives qualifies the absoluteness of human law.
 - John the Baptist's preaching is an example of a proper indictment of present government authority.

Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

Matthew 11:11

- That's what Jesus said of John the Baptist!
- But John is in Prison...
 - For publicly indicting the ruling king!*

For when Herod had John arrested, he bound him and put him in prison because of Herodias, the wife of his brother Philip. For John had been saying to him, "It is not lawful for you to have her."

Matthew 14:3-4 NASB

Opposition to a leader's behavior, public criticism of it, and declaration of moral unfitness for office, is not necessarily inconsistent with a submissive spirit to governing authorities.


For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: **Romans 13:3**

- Contrast with rebellious Jews against Roman law.
 - Claudius expelled all Jews from Rome.
- **Problem:** what is to be done when the “rulers are evil and are a terror to good works”?

Our Stewardship

- Our Unique Mandate:
 - *We elect our rulers!*
 - *As in America: “A government of the people, by the people, and for the people.”*
- But: **We face the illiteracy of the electorate:**
 - Biggest problem: Ignorance or Apathy?
 - **“I don’t know and I don’t care!”**
- First Priority: Be informed! Know the truth about our leadership – and pray for them!
 - The critical role of a free press (**not the BBC et al!**)
 - **The power of Media!**

The Power of Media



It is an abomination for kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by righteousness.

- The **abandonment of righteousness** weakens the seat of government and the stability and security of the country.

Mercy and truth preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy.

- The **abandonment of truth** and loyalty to covenants undermines the leadership of a ruler.

Integrity?

- **Bribery** is a root issue undermining truthfulness
 - Acting on principle rather than driven by expediency.
 - Thus, when integrity is forsaken justice is overthrown.

If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked.

Our Stewardship

- When it comes to elections, is not about political views;
 - It is about character;
 - It is about morality;
 - It is about keeping promises made;
 - If politicians knock on your door, speak to them!
 - Support the Christian Institute and other groups that lobby Parliament

Our Stewardship

- *Our* duty is to stand for what is right.
- Our voting should be in line with Scripture!
 - Not a political persuasion for any other reason
- “Abour that which is evil...”

The Final Vote!

- The poll that can't be ignored has only one vote!
- There is an election coming which has *your* name on the ballot.
 - It will involve a “ballot box” which will receive only *one* relevant vote: God's.
 - The results will not be determined by rhetoric
 - What has *your* voting record been?
- *“There is something far more powerful than even the ballot box: it is the prayer closet”.*

Pray

1. Pray for the King and Prime Minister's repentance and renewal in faith and honesty and purity of heart and body.

- Pray for *Parliament and all politicians*, that its moral leadership might be reinstated.
- That Scripture would once again be cherished

Pray

2. Pray for all of our leaders:

- For discernment and wisdom in their decisions;
- For courage in times of crisis;
- For repentance where their behavior so requires.
- And for the exaltation of God in our land, whose ways and Word have been ignored and despised.

Pray

3. Inform those in governing positions of your views and values.
 - Email addresses readily available
4. Actively support politicians with a scriptural foundation and personal integrity.
5. Hold all politicians accountable.
 - If we care about our children and grandchildren, that should be our consuming commitment.

For he is the minister of God to thee for good.

But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil.

- Pray for our law enforcement officers; they daily put their life on the line to maintain order.
 - Likewise, our armed forces and those who seek to protect our nation

And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages.

Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.

- “Stop owing anything to anyone except...”
- ...the debt of love!

Love worketh no ill to his neighbor: therefore

- Don't let your zeal for a cause have an adverse impact on others!


