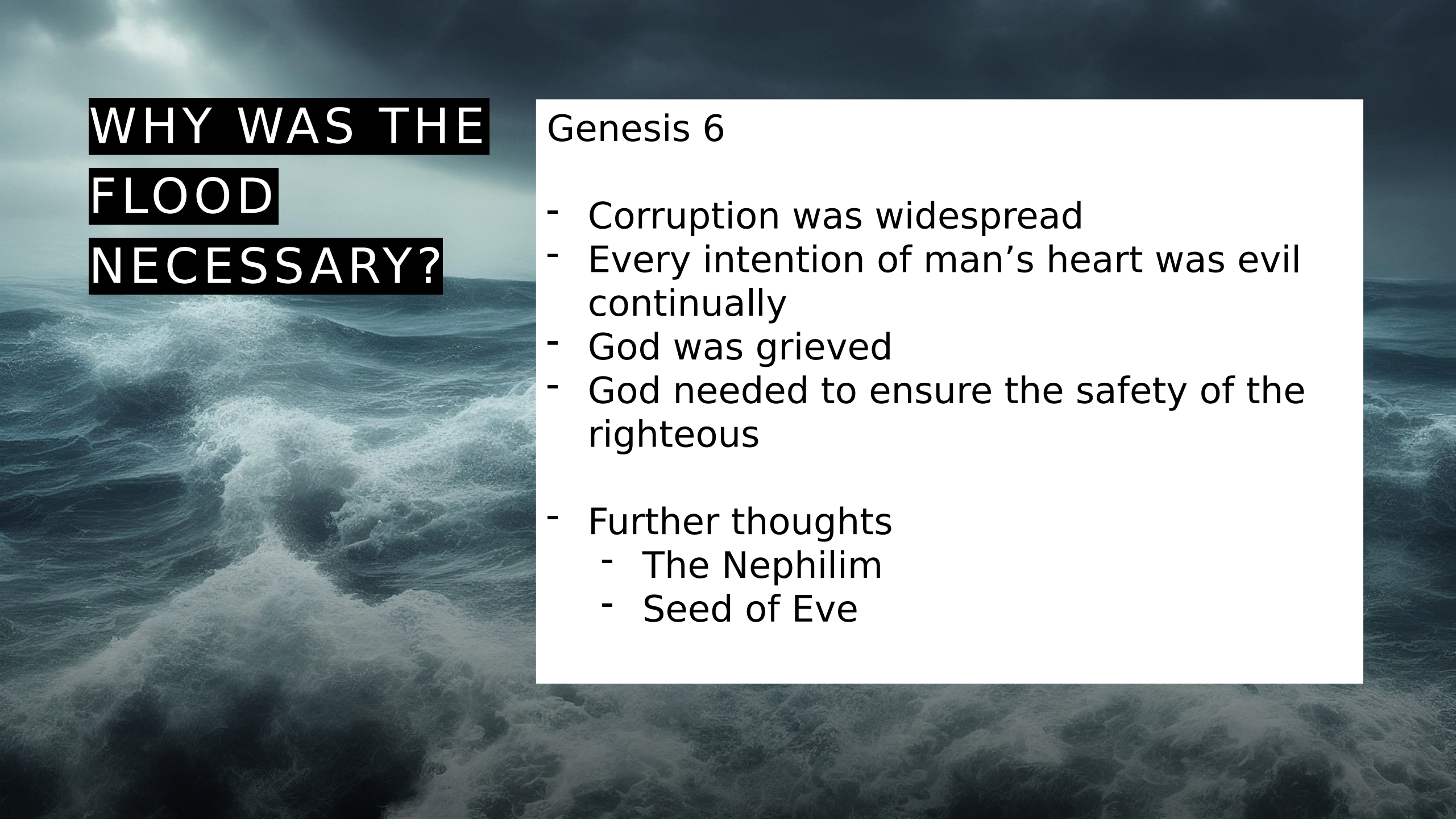

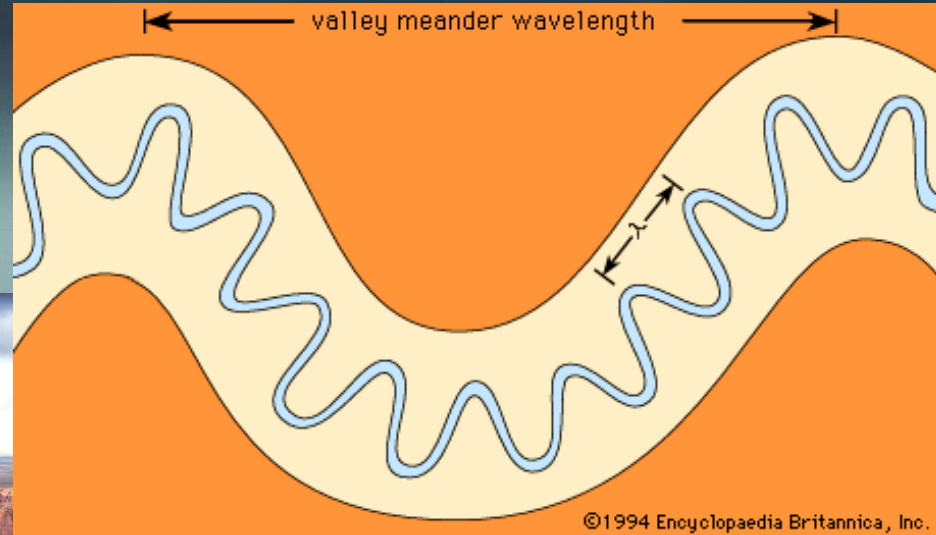

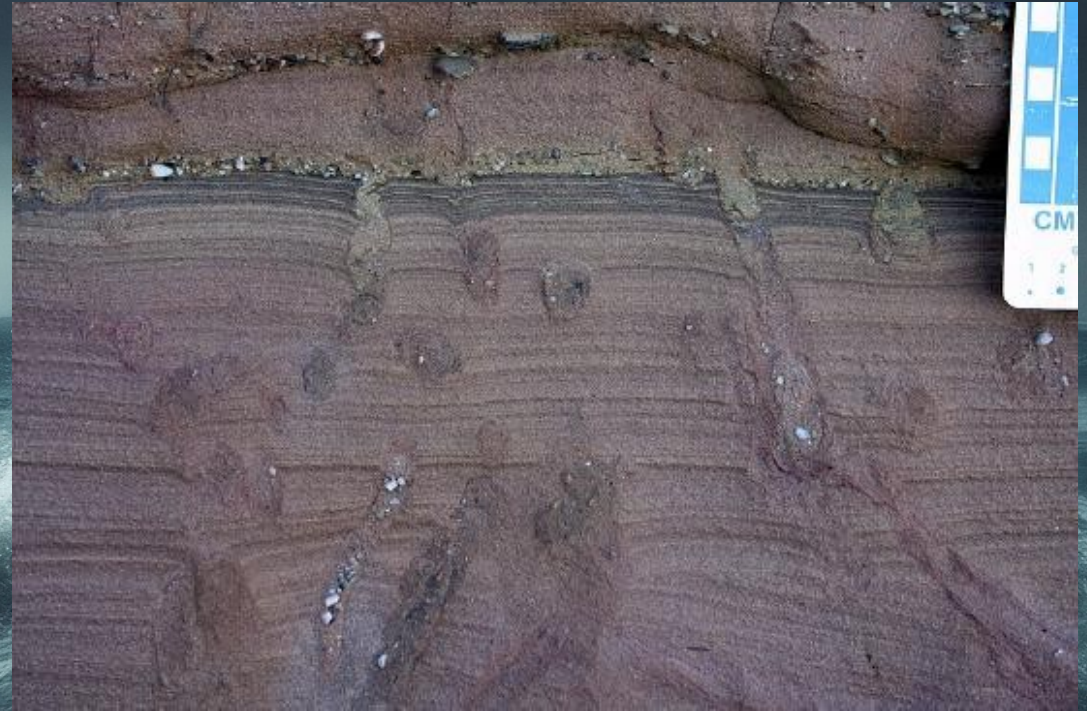
UNDERFIT RIVERS AND WATER GAPS



PLATEAUS

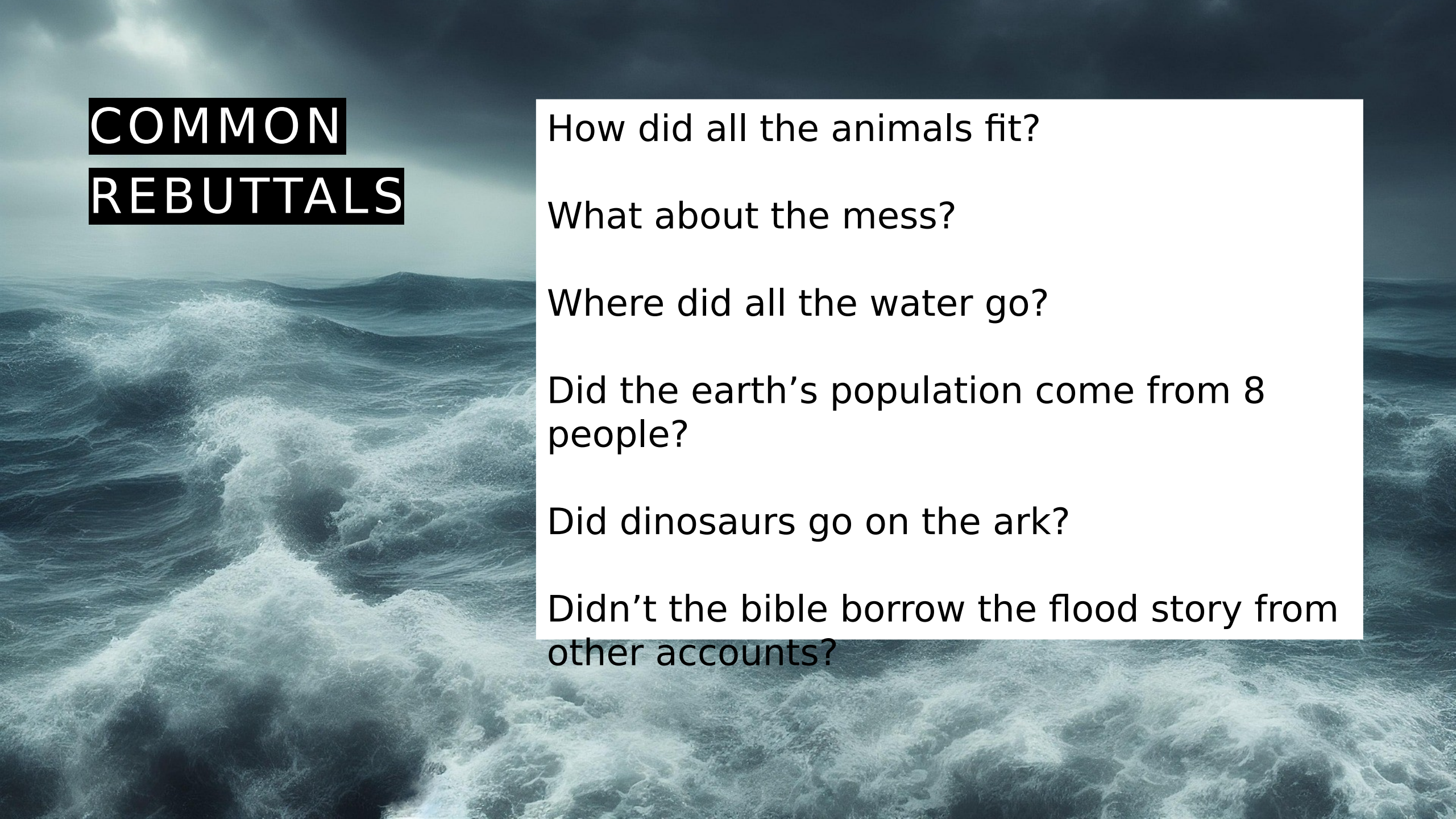


LACK OF BIOTURBATION

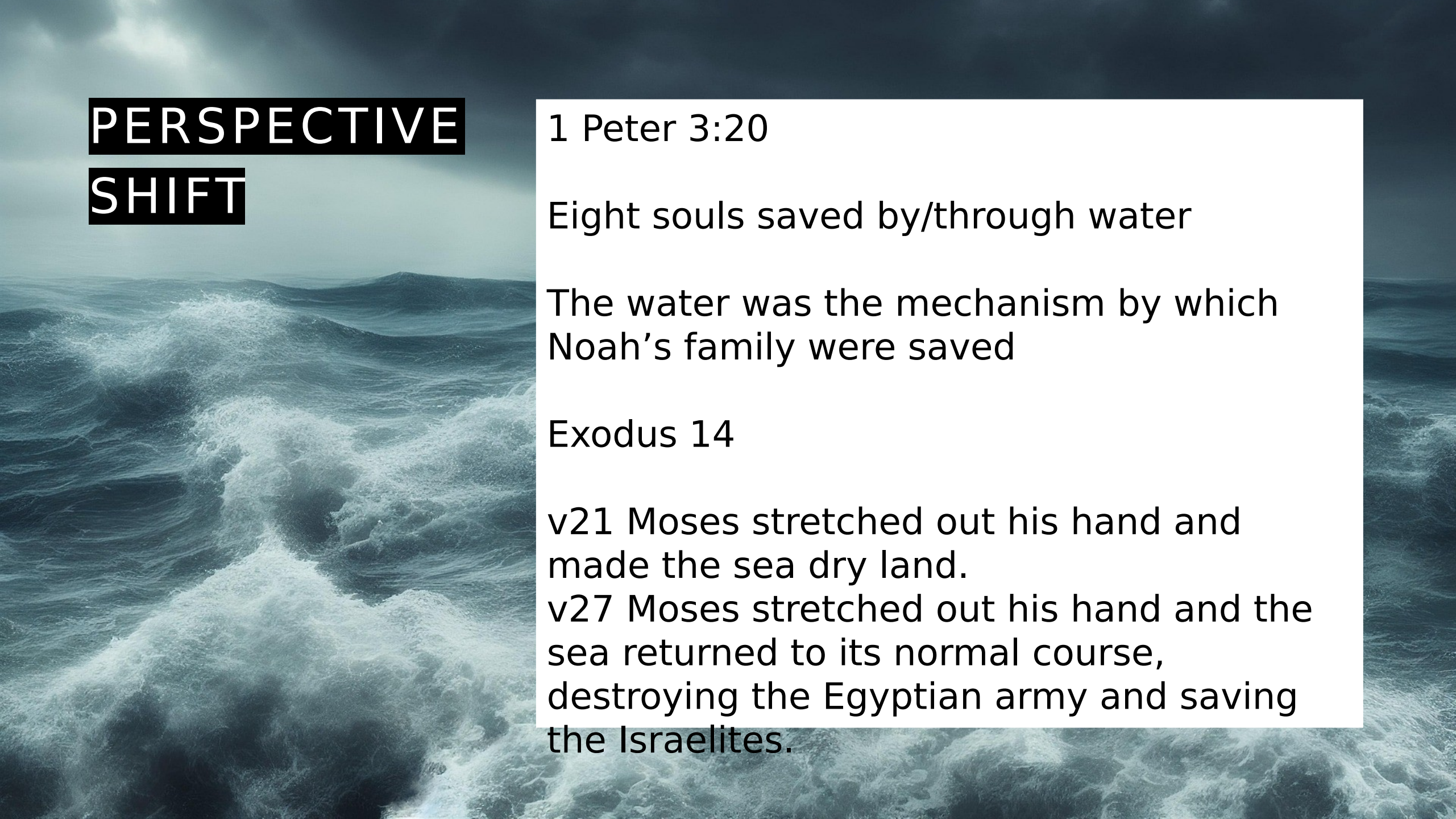

Eight souls saved by/through water

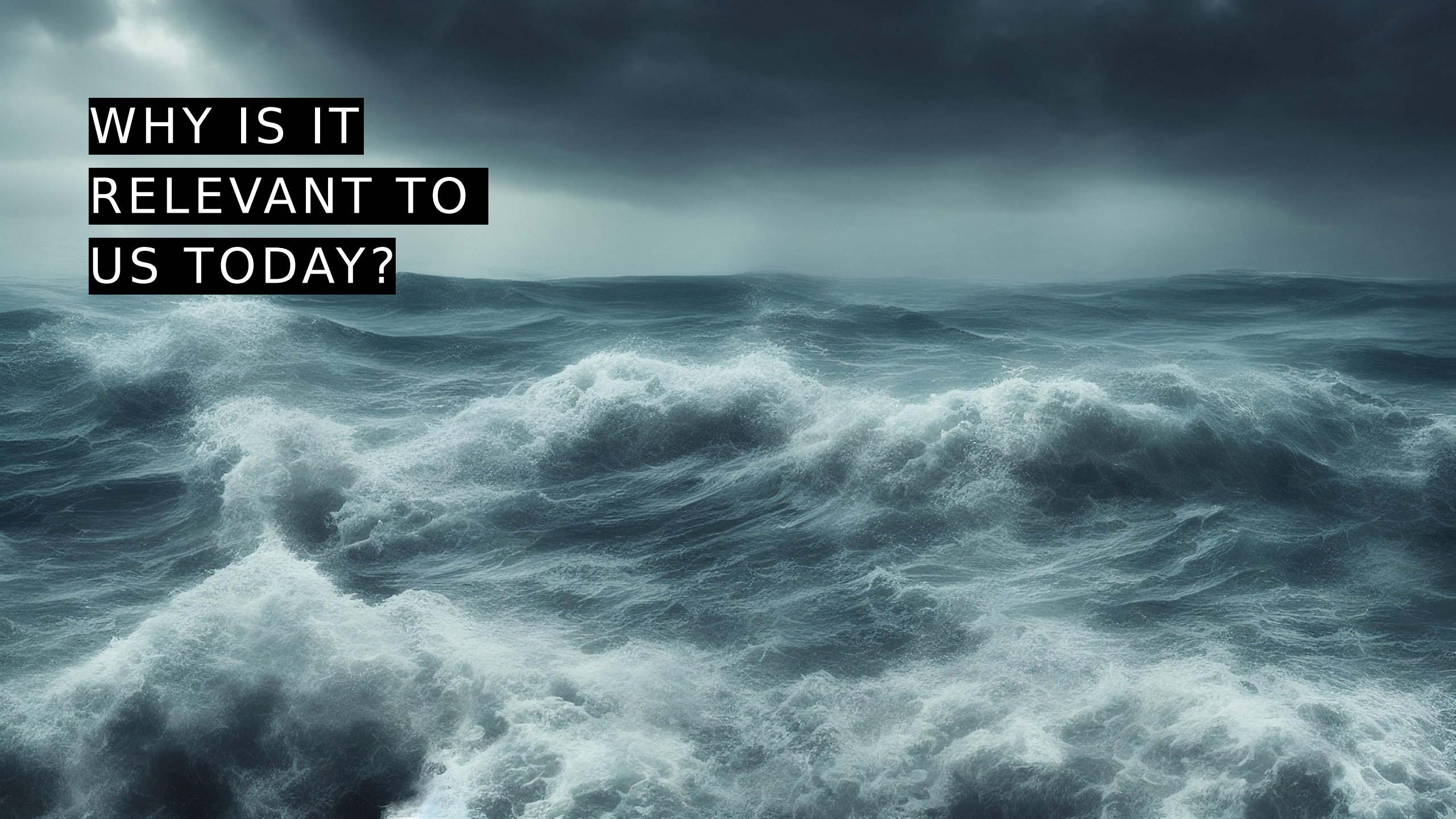
The water was the mechanism by which Noah's family were saved

v21 Moses stretched out his hand and made the sea dry land.

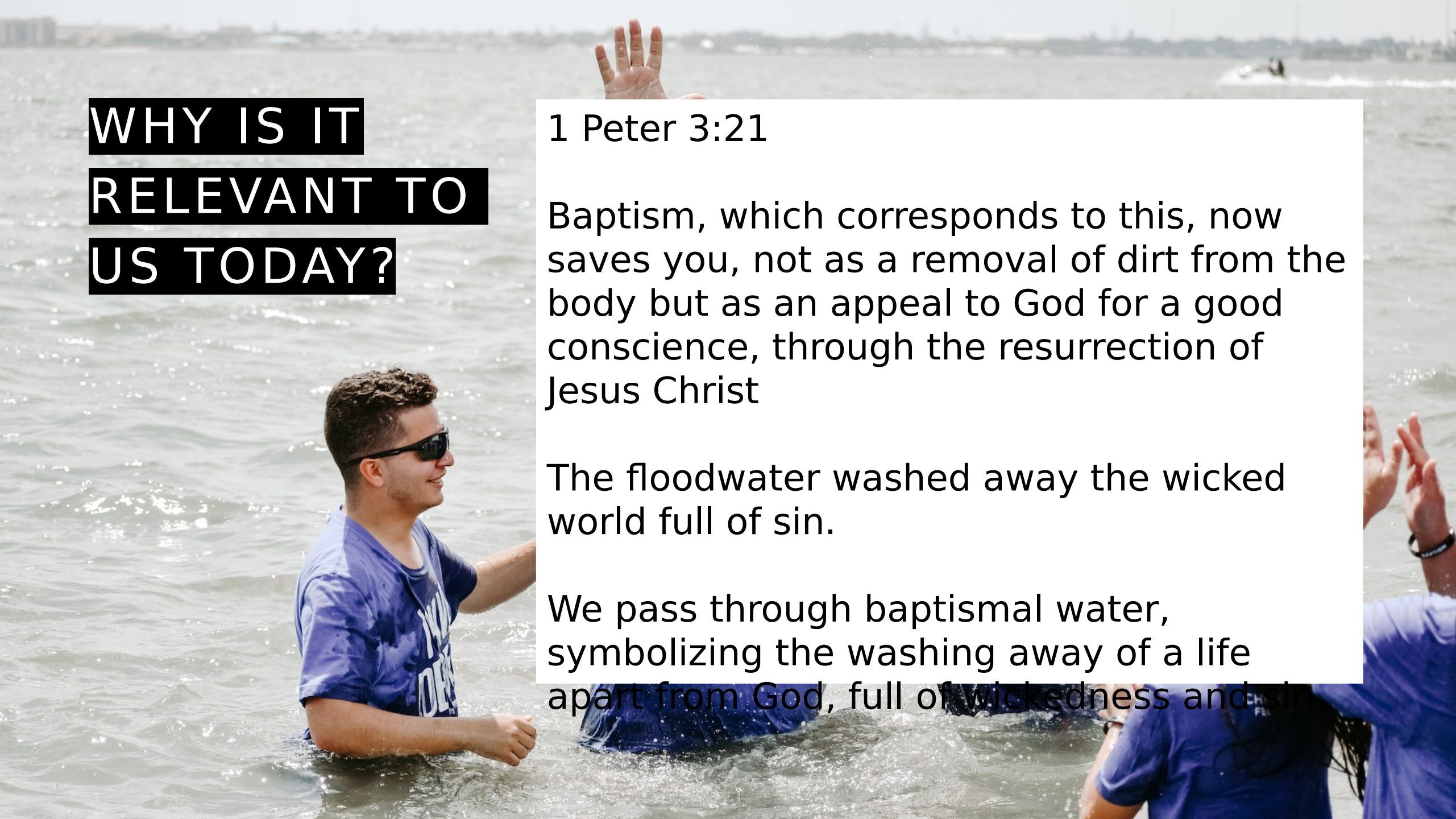
v27 Moses stretched out his hand and the sea returned to its normal course, destroying the Egyptian army and saving the Israelites.

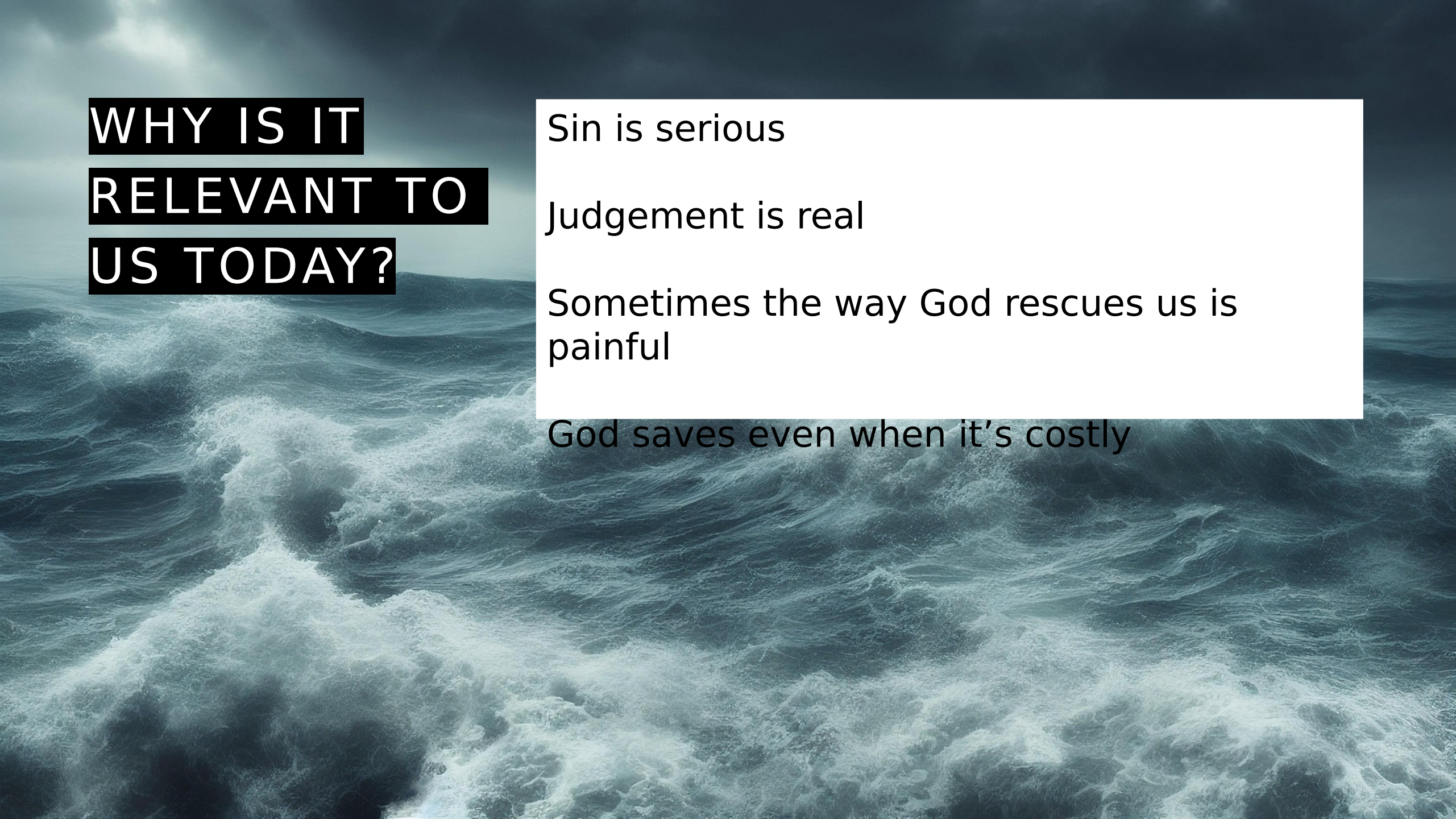
WHY IS IT RELEVANT TO US TODAY?

1 Peter 3:21

Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ
