# Introduction to Chapter 6

- One third of the Bible is Prophecy.
- Prophecy is not a prediction about the future, it is history recorded in advance.
- Prophecy is unique to God & the Bible.
- God is outside of time, and one of the tests He gives to prove His sovereignty, and the inspiration of Scripture is His unique ability to tell the future before it happens.

# The Day of the LORD

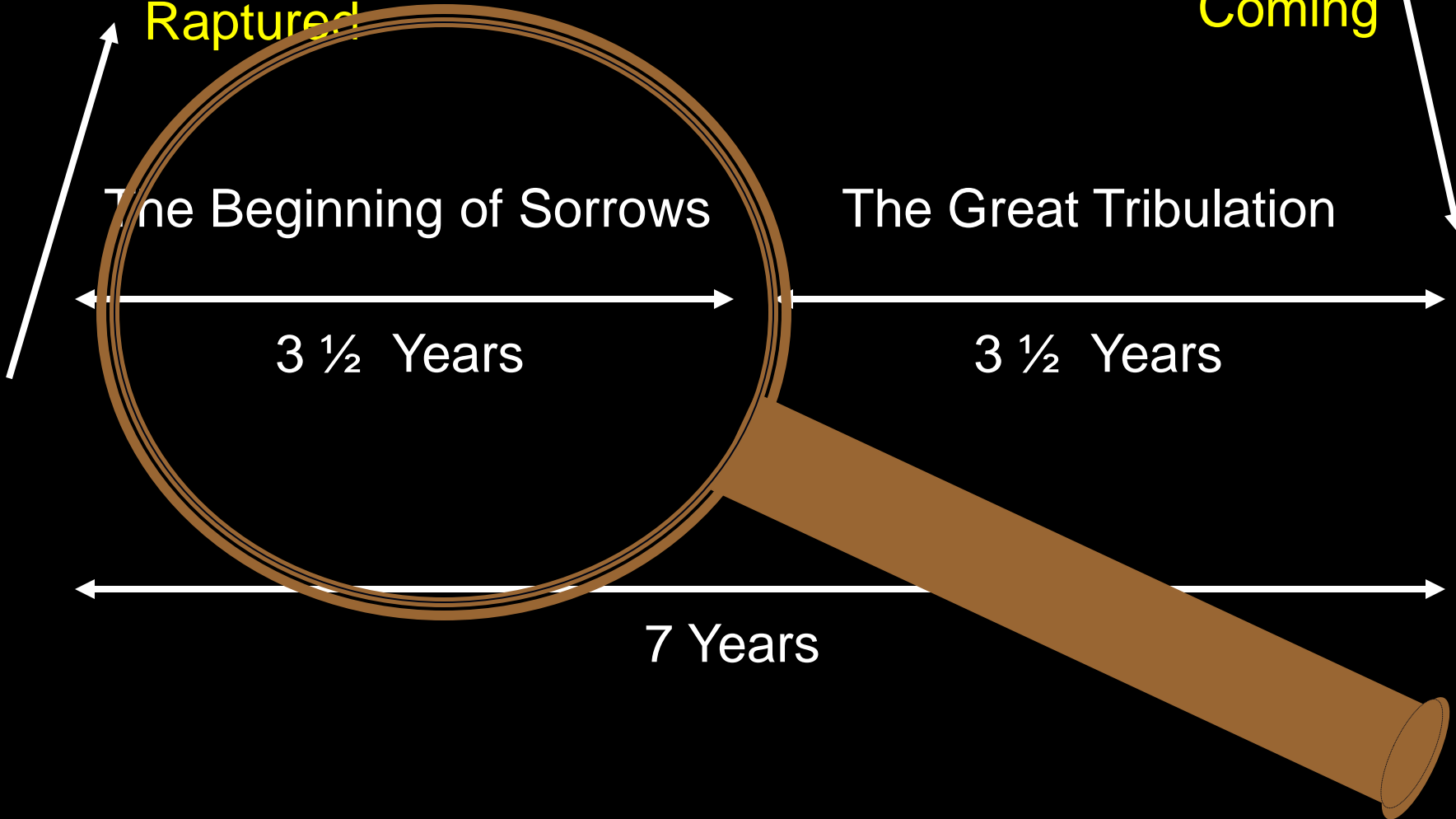

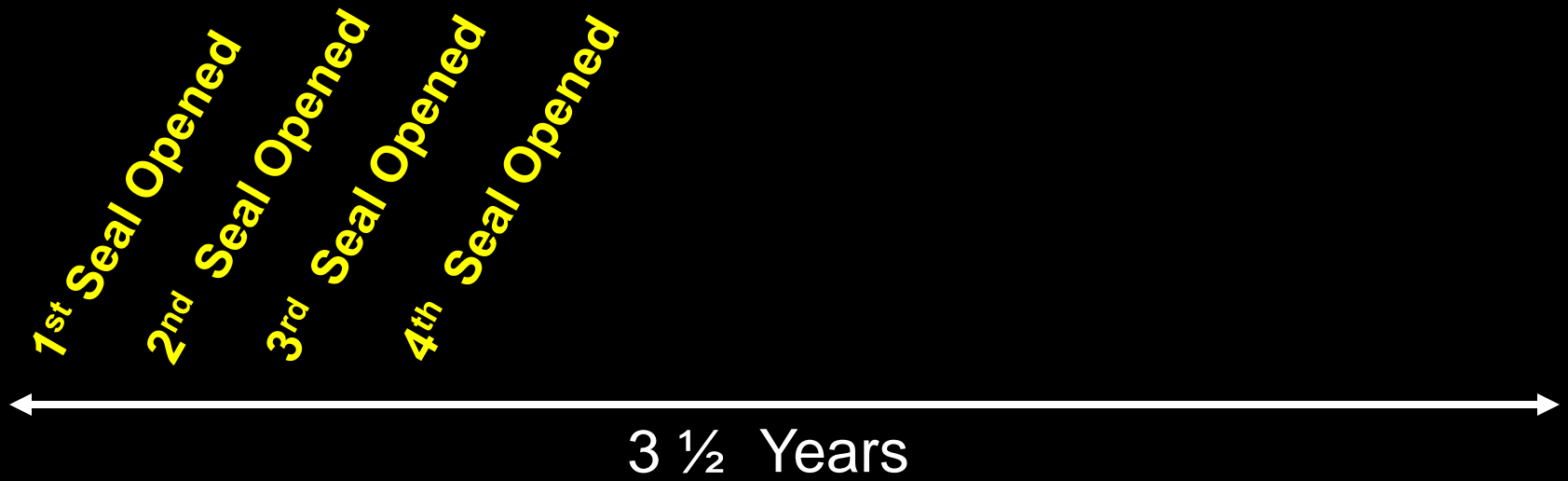

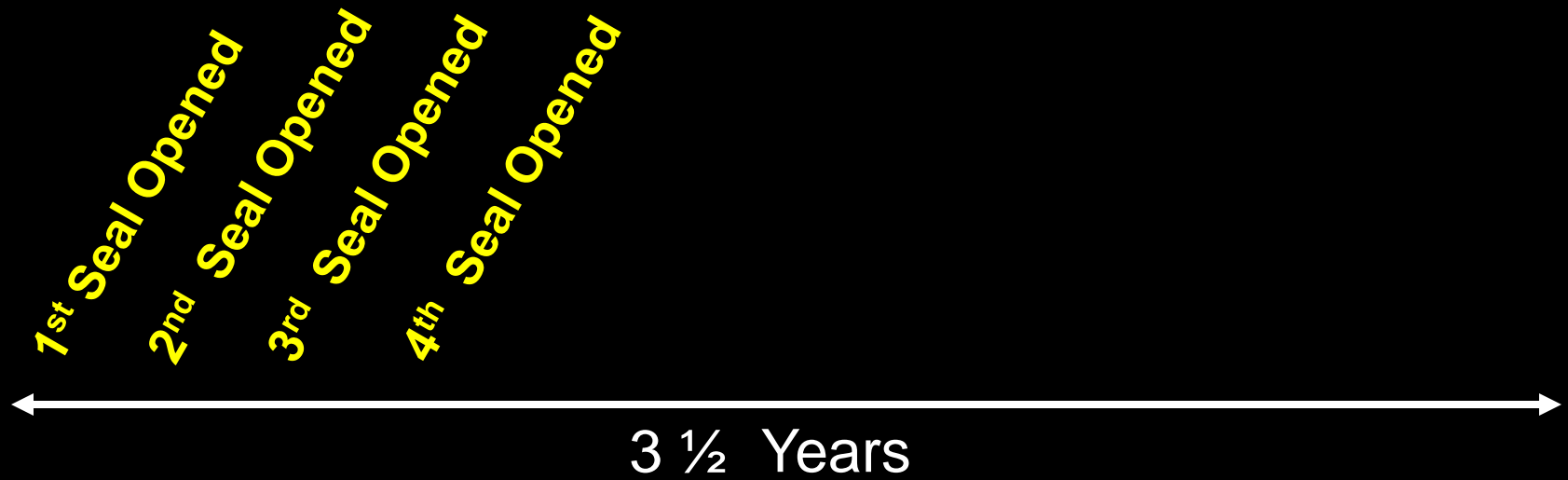
# The Forth Seal

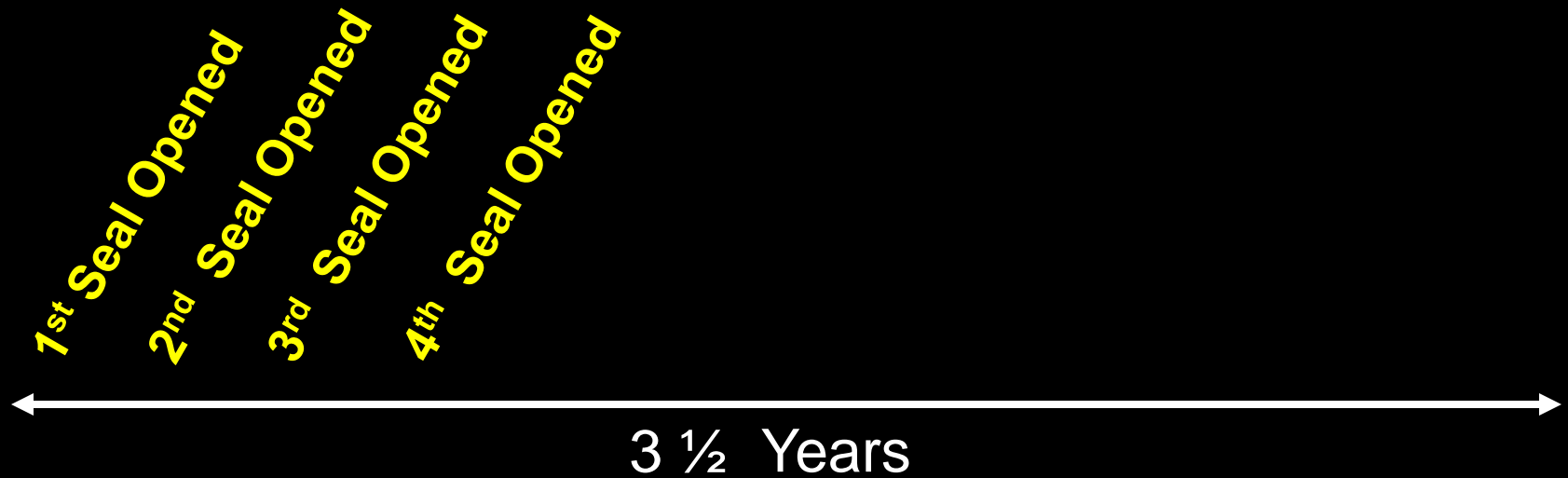

Rider on a **Pale** horse –  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the population dies

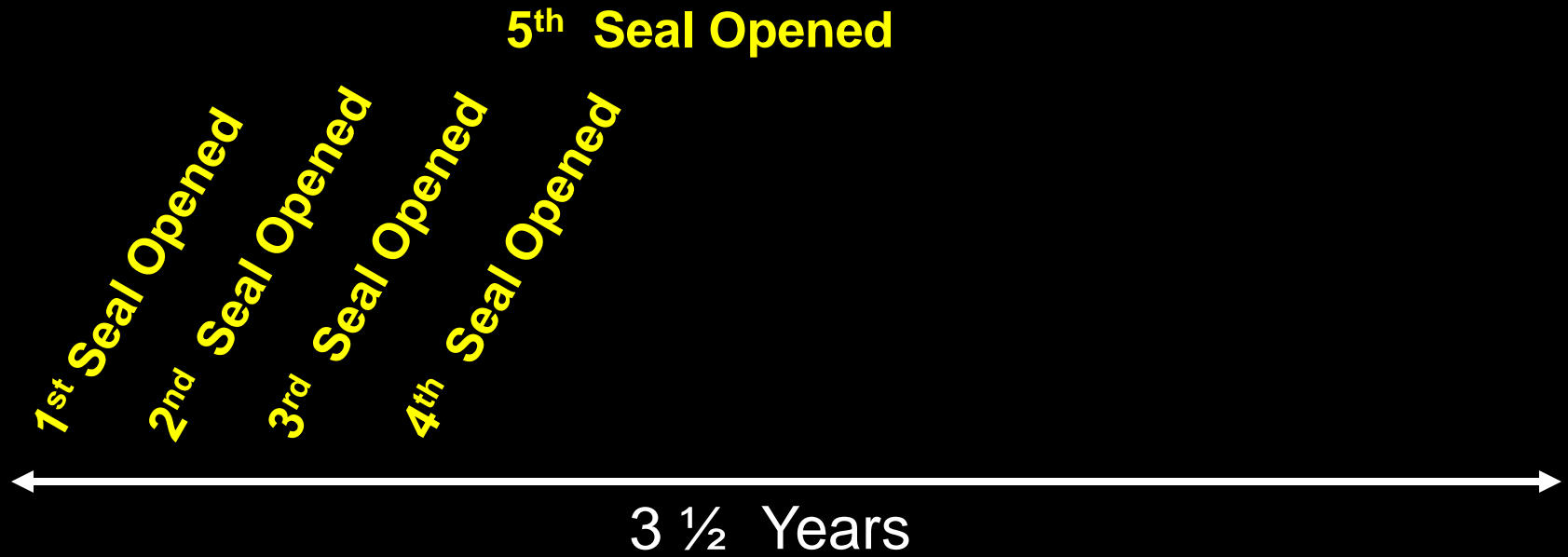
# The Forth Seal

# The Fifth Seal

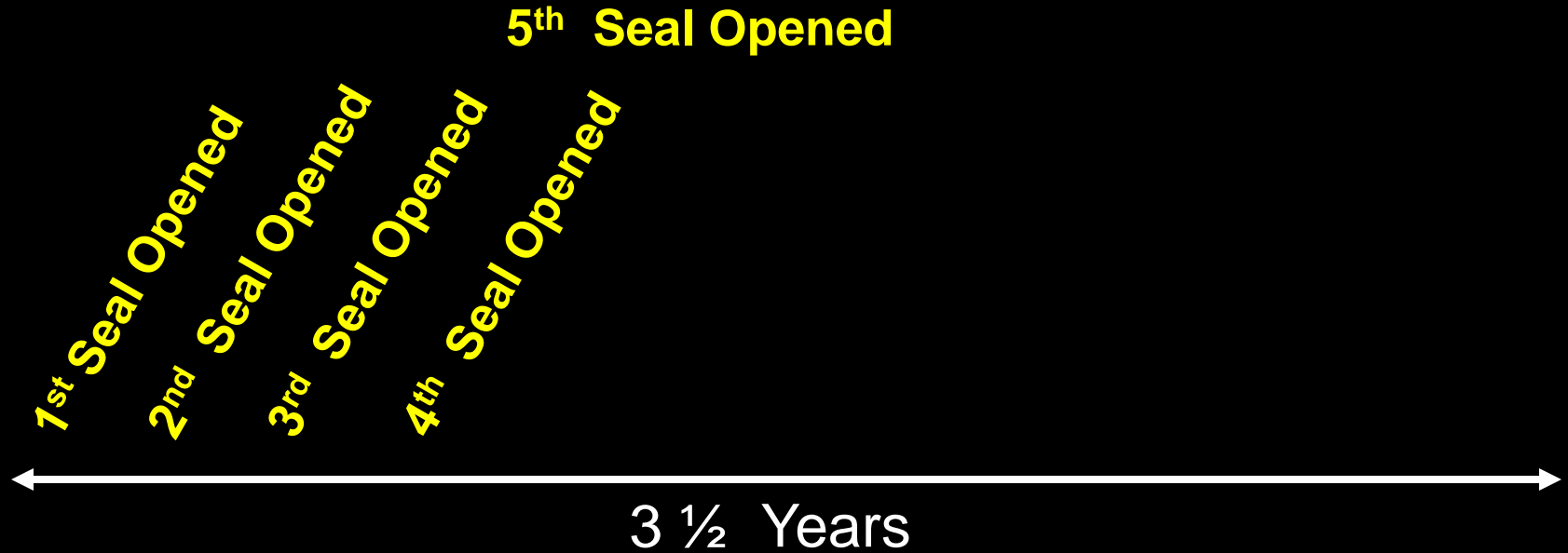




- 9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

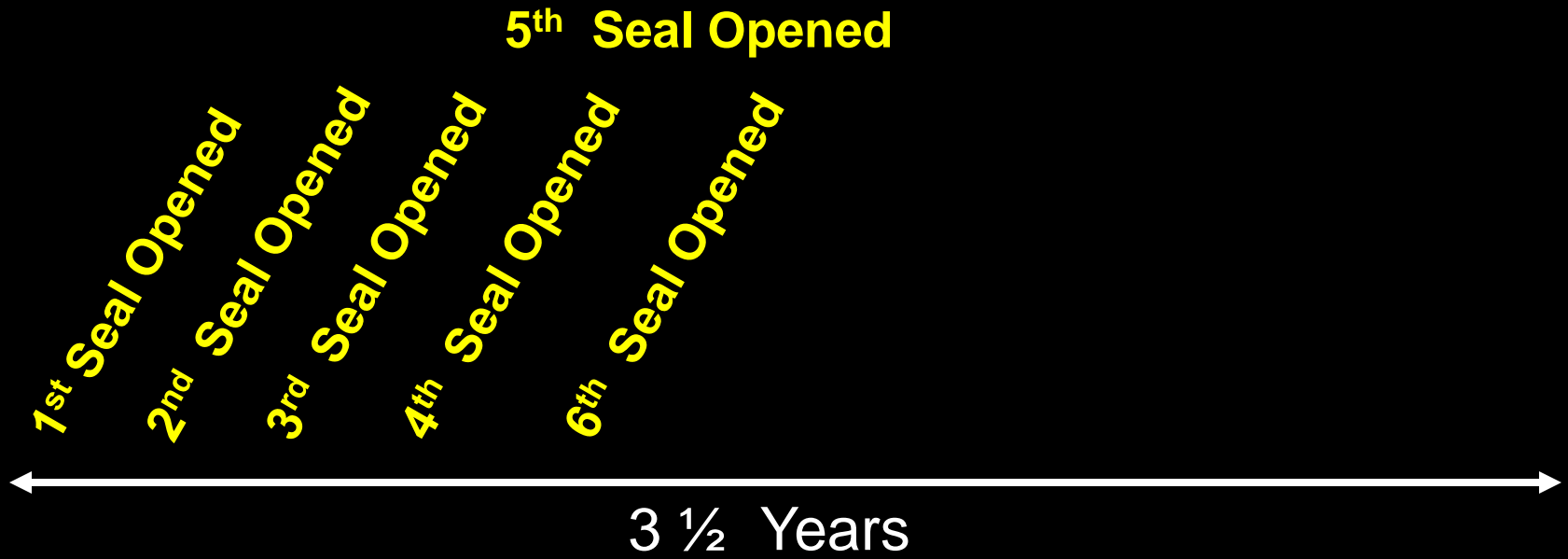


John sees martyred saints in Heaven

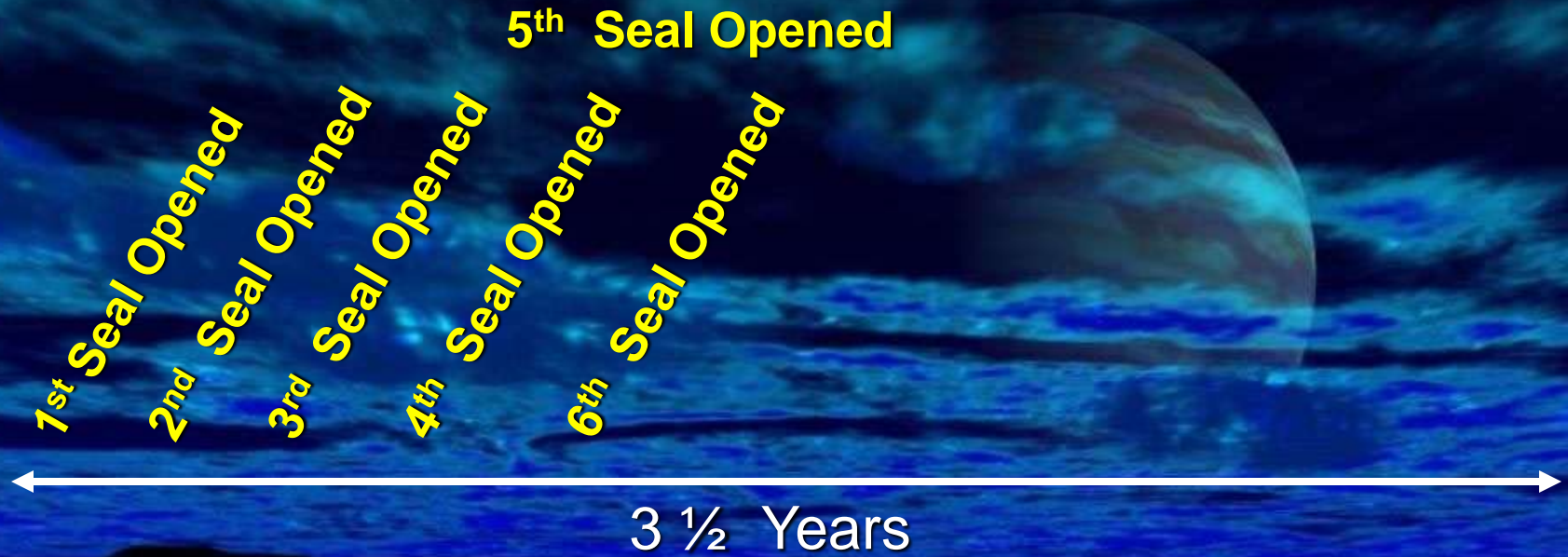
# The Sixth Seal
