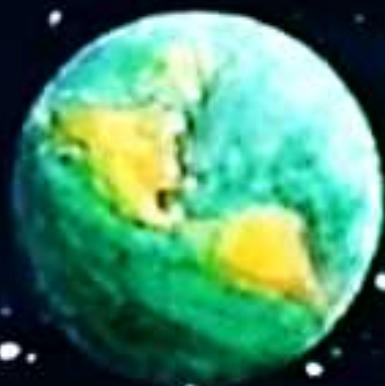

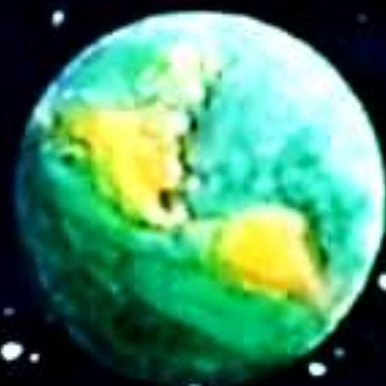

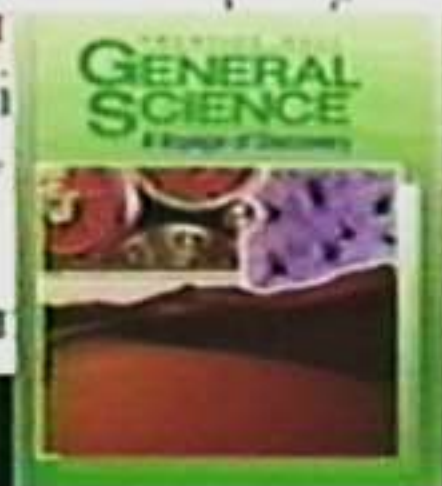

The Birth and Death of the Universe

How was the universe born and how will it end? Most astronomers believe that about 18 to 20 billion years ago all the matter in the universe was concentrated into one very dense, very hot region that may have been much smaller than a period on this page. For some unknown reason, this region exploded. This explosion is called the big bang. On the big bang was the formation of galaxies away from one another. This explains why the universe is still expanding.

17.6 The Origin of the Universe

If the universe is expanding, then it must have once been much smaller. If you could run the life of the universe in reverse, like a film, you would see the universe contracting until it disappeared in a flash of light, leaving nothing.

In the realm of the universe, nothing really means nothing. Not only matter and energy would disappear, but also space and time. However, physicists theorize that from this state of nothingness the universe began in a gigantic explosion about 16.5 billion years ago. This theory of the origin of the universe is called the Big Bang theory. The Big Bang theory does not explain how the universe began. The theory only explains how the existing universe could have developed.

Facts you need to know!

- There is no universally accepted 'big bang' theory
 - There are various hypotheses (guesses)
- The 'big bang' theory' is not/cannot be science.
 - Science demands observation using one or more of our five senses (taste, touch, sight, smell, hearing) and repeatable experimentation
- The 'big bang' theory' is a belief system about our origins
 - Thus the 'big bang' theory is by definition a religion

Facts you need to know!

The 'high priest' of Evolution, Dr Richard Dawkins said the following in a BBC Radio 2 interview:

(The Jeremy Vine Show, BBC Radio 2. January 5, 2006)

- *“Religion demands belief in the supernatural”*
 - *Nothing exploding & becoming everything?*
- *“Religion requires belief in things that cannot be verified by science”*
 - *Spontaneous generation of life? Formation of DNA? Transitional forms?*
- *“The time has come for people of reason to say: enough is enough. Religious faith discourages independent thought, it's divisive, and it's dangerous.”*

Scientific Problems?

In astrophysics, the questions of galaxy formation and evolution are:

- *How, from a homogeneous universe, did we obtain the very inhomogeneous one we live in?*
- *How did galaxies form?*
- *How do galaxies change over time?*

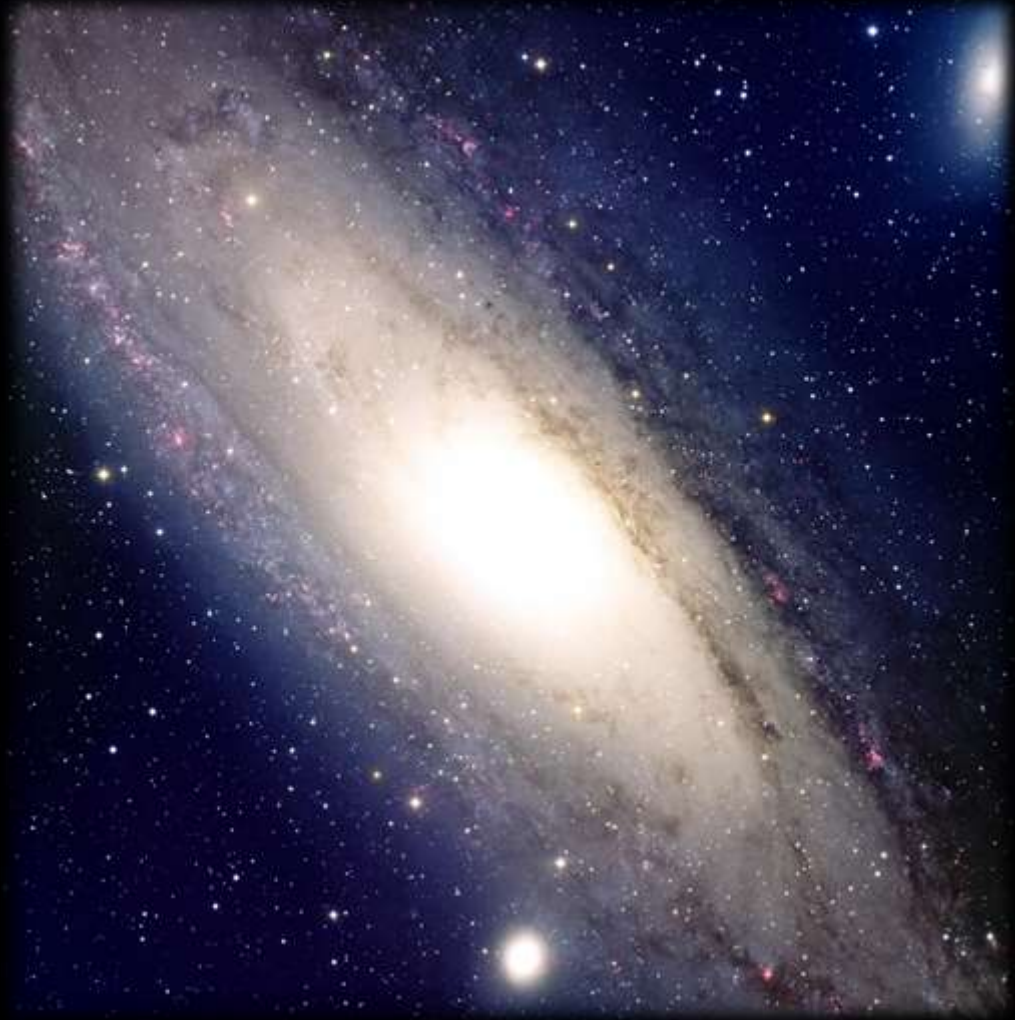
Homogenous :composed of similar or identical parts or elements

Galaxy Formation

The earliest modern theory of the formation of our **galaxy** describes a single (relatively) rapid monolithic collapse.....**Another view published in 1978** describes a more gradual process.....**An even more recent idea** is that significant portions of the stellar halo could be stellar debris from destroyed dwarf galaxies and globular clusters.....Giant elliptical galaxies are **probably formed** by.....etc.,etc.

While we have learned a great deal about ours and other galaxies, the most fundamental questions about formation and evolution remain only tentatively answered.

Star Formation

According to **current theories of star formation**, cores of molecular clouds (regions of especially high density) become gravitationally unstable, fragment and begin to collapse (sometimes, shockwaves from supernovae will trigger star formation in nearby gas clouds).

The youngest and brightest stars we now see in the Orion Nebula are **thought to be** less than **300,000 years old**, and the brightest **may be** only **10,000 years in age**.

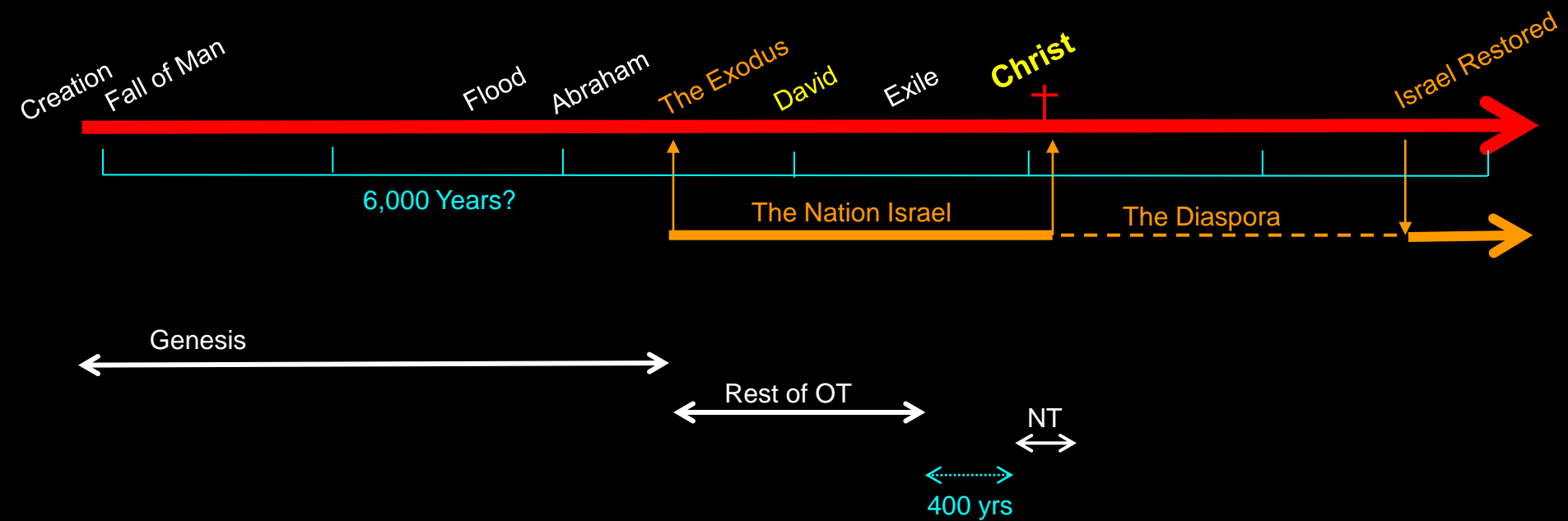

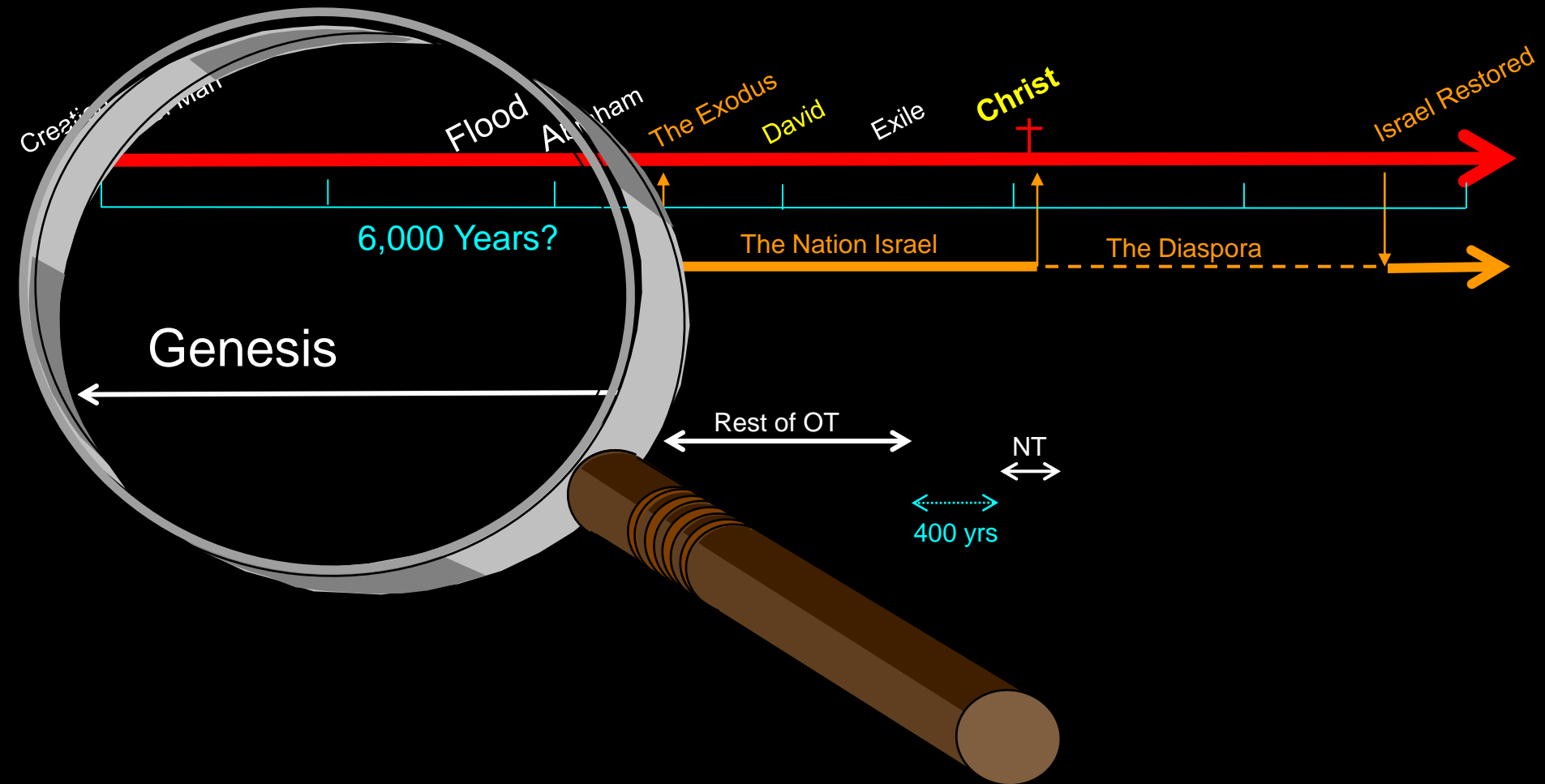

How do mainline Protestant clergy stand on theological issues such as biblical infallibility? Many take a decidedly nonconformist view, according to a survey of 7,441 ministers conducted by sociologist Jeffrey Haden.

Here are the percentages of ministers who answered “No” to the following questions, by denomination:

Question: *Do you accept Jesus’ physical resurrection as a fact?*

Methodist ministers 51% / Episcopalian ministers 35% / American Baptist ministers 33% / Presbyterian ministers, 30% / American Lutheran ministers, 13%

Question: *Do you believe in the virgin birth of Jesus?*

Methodist ministers 60% / Presbyterian ministers, 49% / Episcopalian ministers 44% / American Baptist ministers 34% / American Lutheran ministers, 19%

Question: *Do you believe the scriptures are the inerrant work of God in faith, history and secular matters?*

Episcopalian ministers 95% / Methodist ministers 87% / Presbyterian ministers, 82% / American Lutheran ministers, 77% / American Baptist ministers 67%

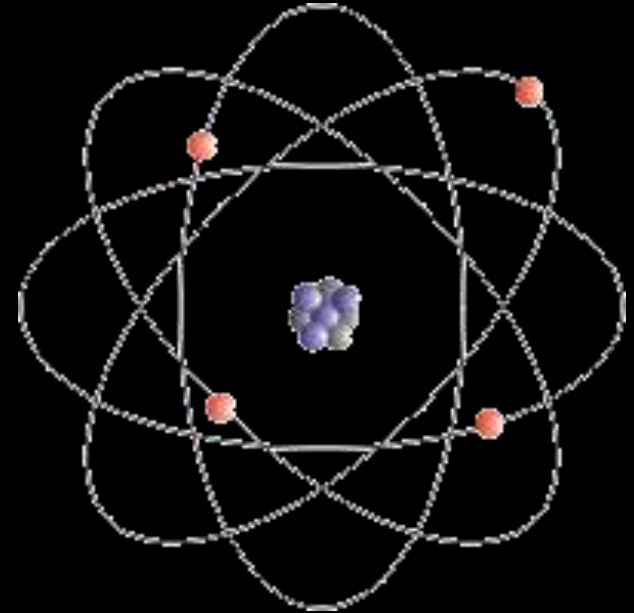

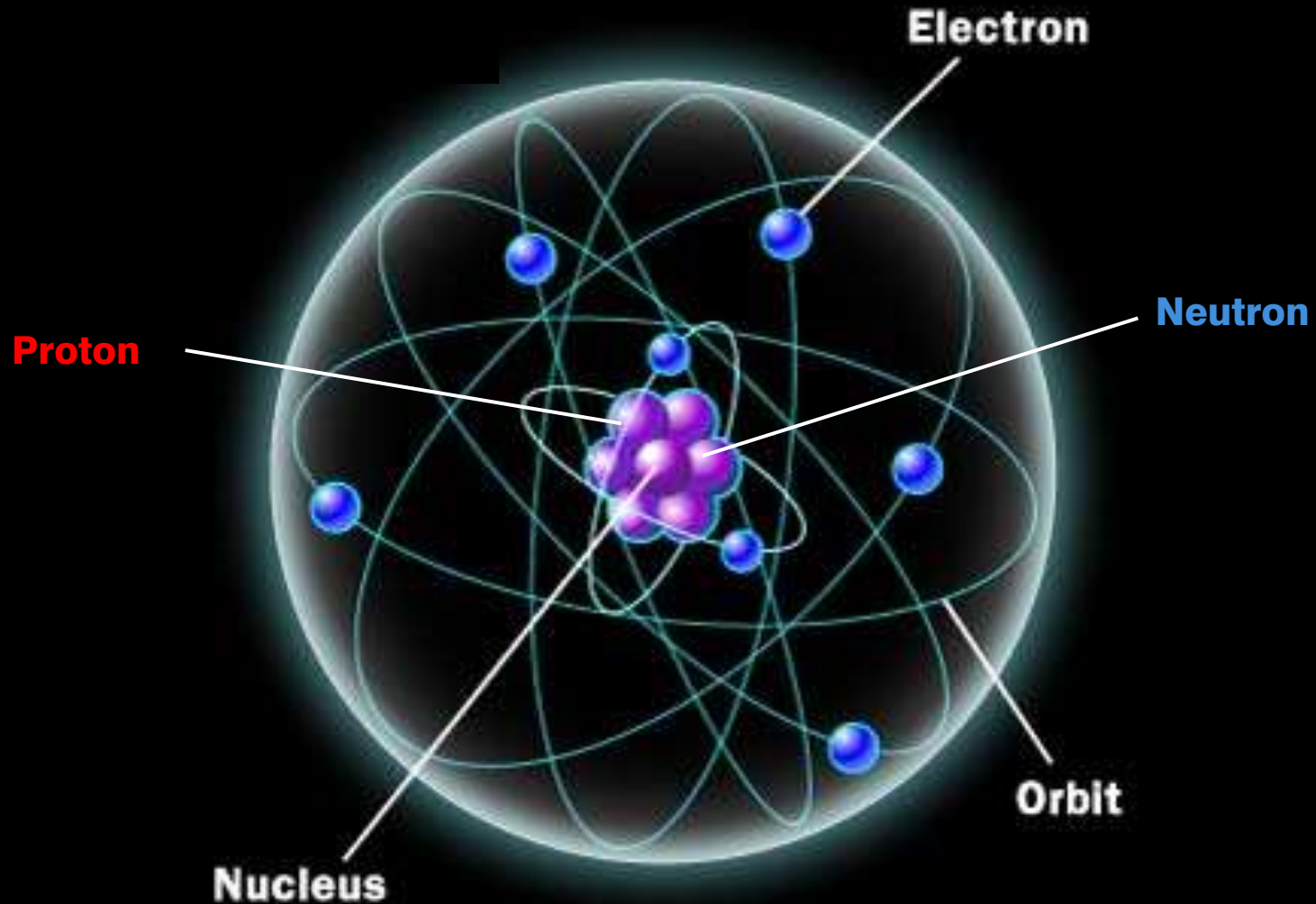
