

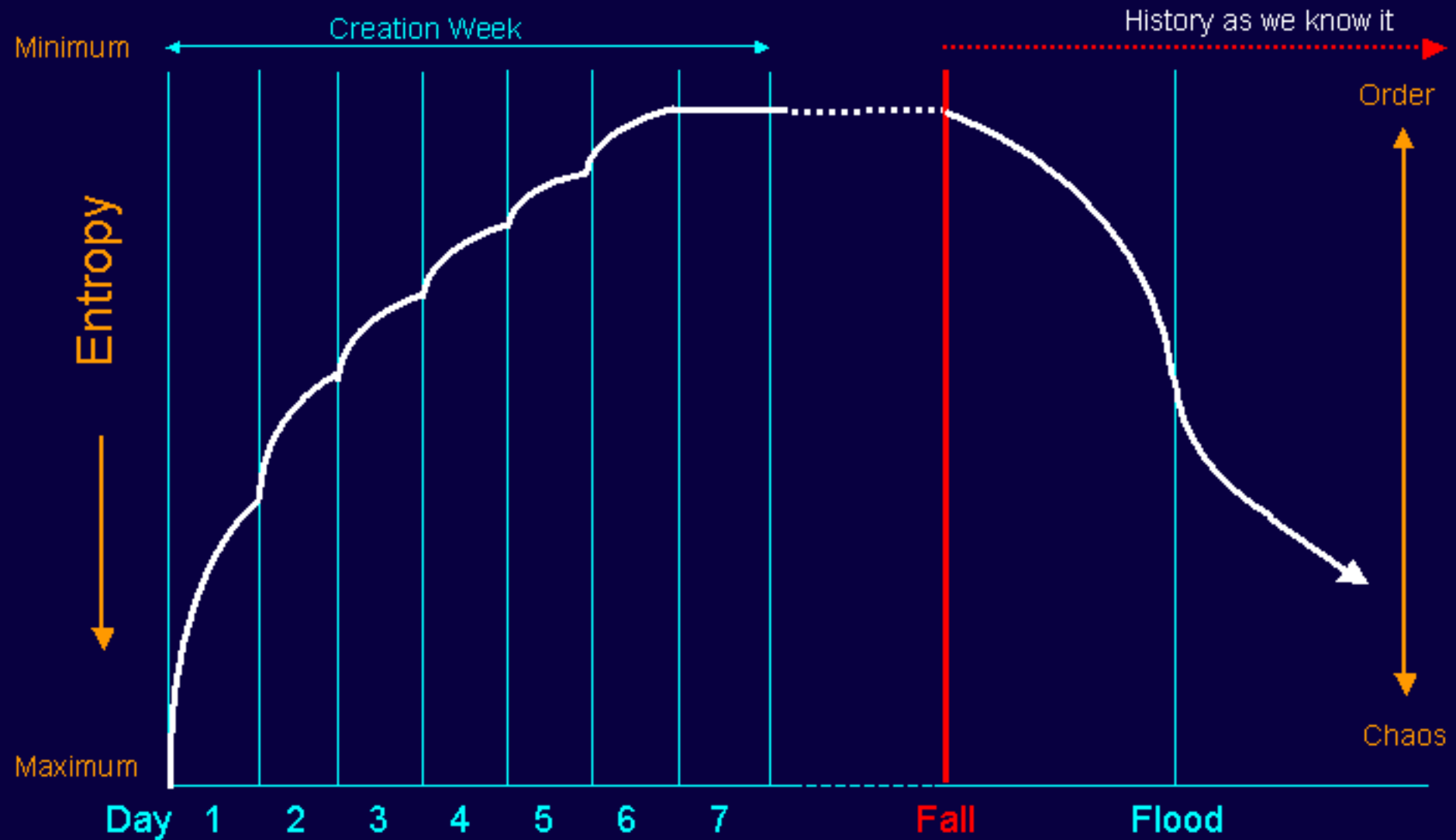

The Post Flood World

- The world Noah stepped off the Ark into is the world in which we now live
- It was very different than the pre-flood world
- The world now had a new hydro-system
- The Earth had undergone an Axis shift
- The universal climate had gone
- The world would now be subject to seasons
- Oxygen level dropped dramatically
- Lifespans now significantly shortened
- Many species became extinct

- 19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.
- 20 For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope,
- 21 Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
- 22 For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now.

A New Beginning

- Man was no longer only vegetarian (9:3)
- Capital punishment introduced (9:5-6)
- Shem's descendants chosen (9:26-27)

I And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

Gen 8:1

- God never forgets!
- His promises are yes and amen!
 - 'Wind': Hebrew 'Ruach' (the same as Spirit)
- God's plan was going just fine!

2 The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

3 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated.

Gen 8:2-3

4 And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.

Gen 8:4

- There are no meaningless details in the Bible!
- Every details is there by deliberate supernatural design!
- Note the date 'new life' begins on the earth

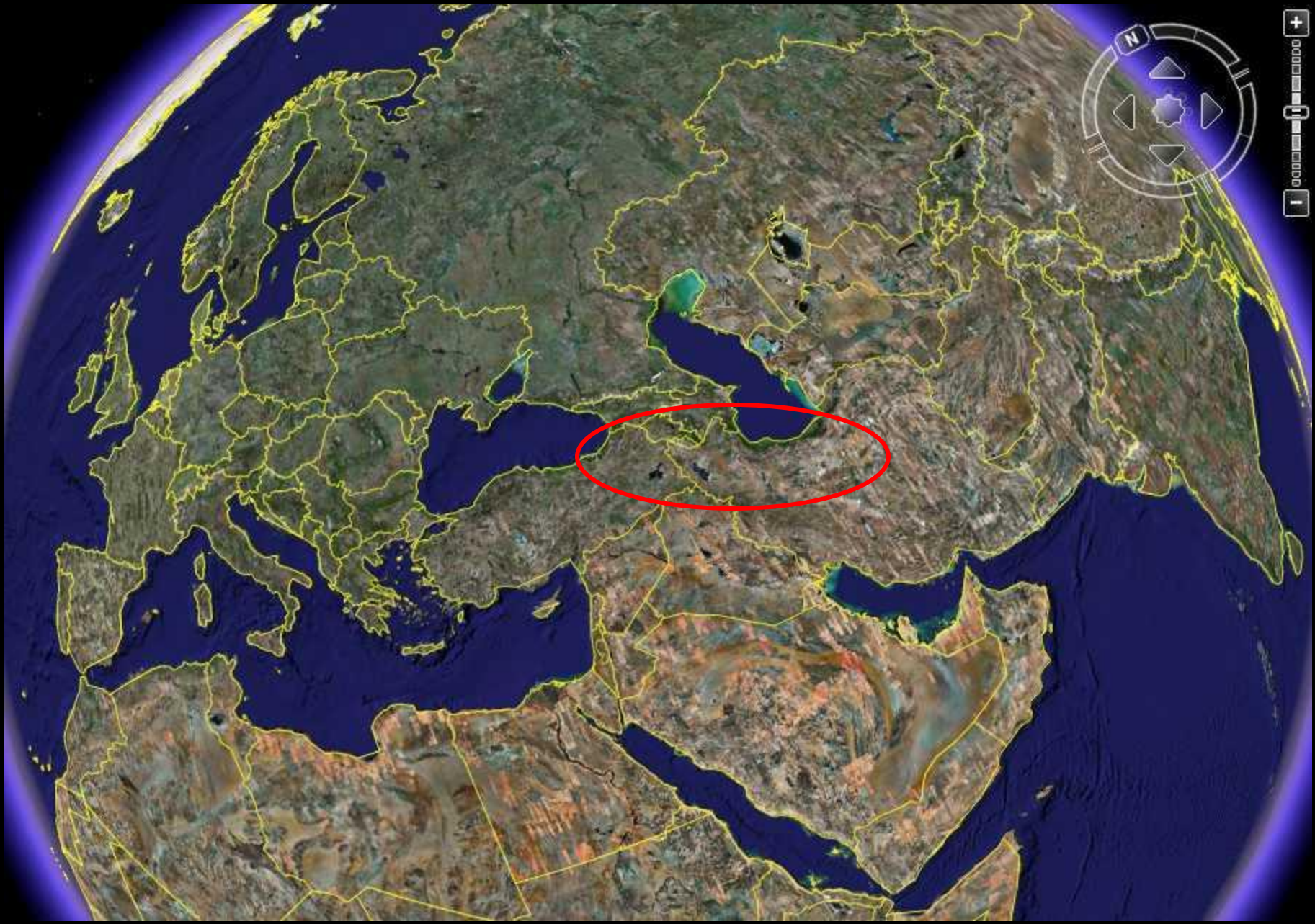

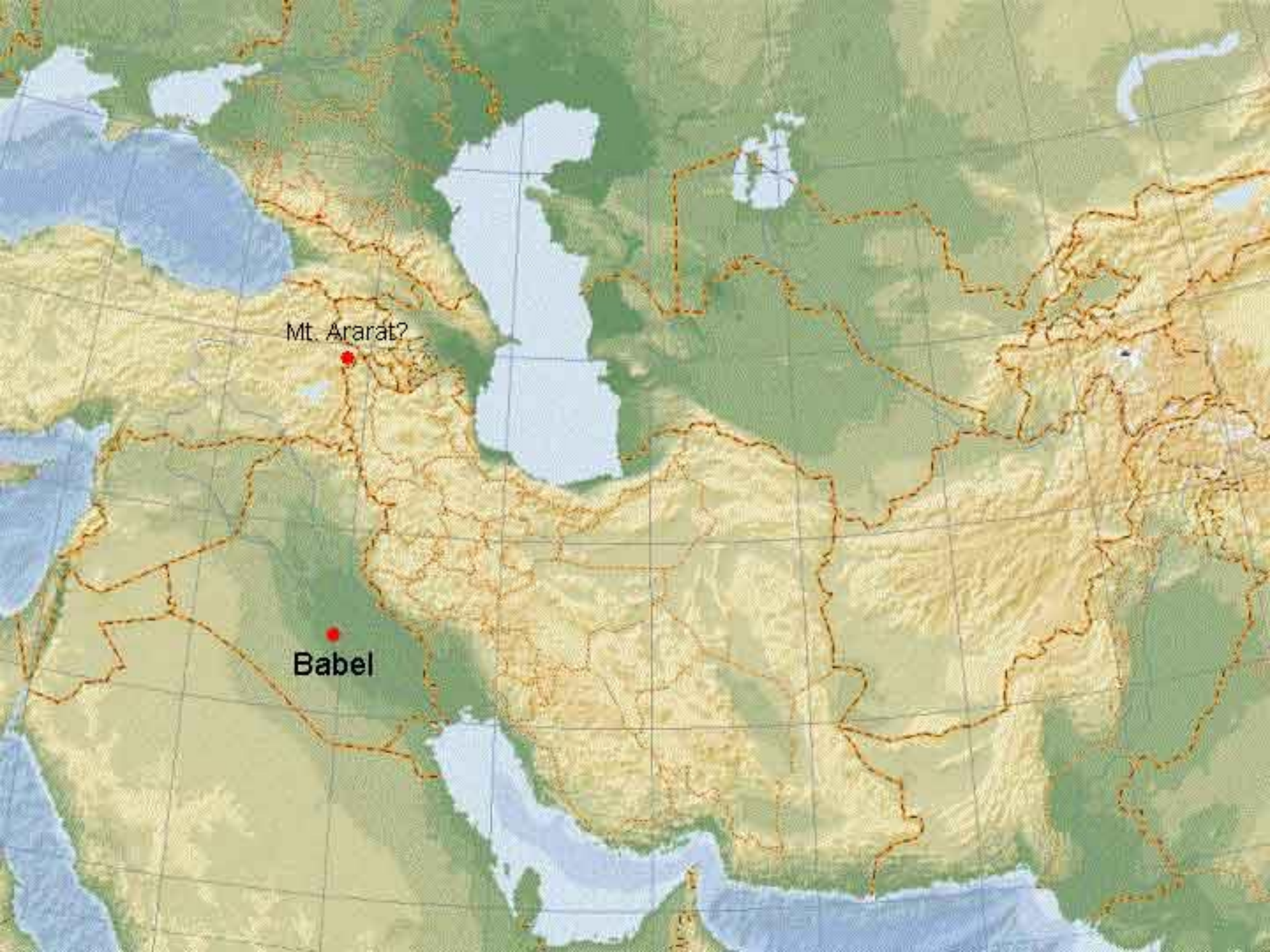

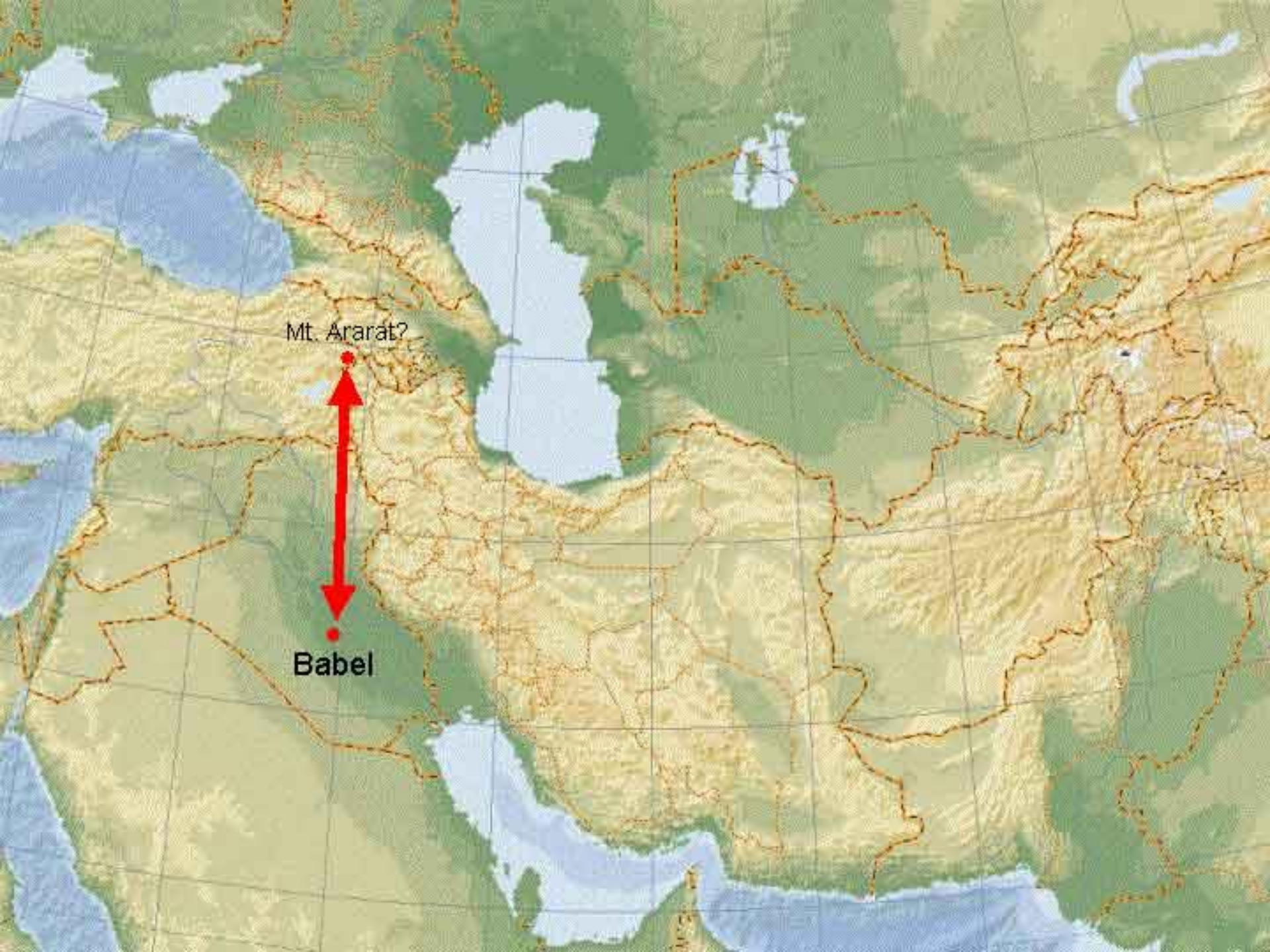
Earlier Sightings

Genesis 8

- 5 And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth month, on the first day of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen.
- 6 And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made:
- 7 And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.
- 8 Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground;

9 But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

*15 And God spake unto Noah, saying,
16 Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons,
and thy sons' wives with thee.*

Gen 8:15-16

- Noah waits almost two months before leaving the Ark – until God says so.

God's Timing

- **Abraham:** God had promised a son, the fulfilment was taking it's time, so Abraham 'helps out'
- **Israel:** wanted a king – God had promised one, but the nation couldn't wait & got Saul
- **Saul:** couldn't wait for Samuel and 'lost' the kingdom as a result – **1 Samuel 13**
- **Jesus & the Throne of David:** – **Luke 1:32**
John the Baptist, Jesus' disciples & the Jews expected Jesus to re-establish David's Throne and defeat Rome there and then

Genesis 8

- 15 And God spake unto Noah, saying,*
- 16 Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee.*
- 17 Bring forth with thee every living thing that is with thee, of all flesh, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.*

Genesis 8

18 And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him:

19 Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, and whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

20 And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

- 5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- 6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:
- 7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

- We now have 7.5 billion people on earth
- But it took from Noah to 1804 to reach 1 billion

⁸ And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, ⁹ And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you; ¹⁰ And with every living creature that is with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth. ¹¹ And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth.

Not For Kings

- 4 It is not for kings, O Lemuel, it is not for kings to drink wine; nor for princes strong drink:
- 5 Lest they drink, and forget the law, and pervert the judgment of any of the afflicted.
- 6 Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.
