- The picture is an aid to help remember the star names

- Spica = Ear of Corn / Branch / The Seed
- Zavijaveh = Gloriously beautiful
- Al Mureddin = who shall have dominion
 - Coma = the Desired
 - Centaurus = the Despised
 - Bootes = The Coming One
 - Arcturus = He Cometh
 - Al Katurops = treading under foot
 - Nekka = the pierced

Leo – The Lion

- Regulus = treading under foot
- Denebola = the judge cometh
- Deneb Aleced = the judge shall reign
 - Hydra = the fleeing serpent
 - Crater = the cup of fire
 - Corvus = the ravens (will eat Rev 19)

The Planet Mars

- <u>All</u> the ancient cultures feared Mars
- The Roman god of war
- Homer described 'Ares' as 'bane of mortals'
- Areopagus 'Mars Hill' seat of Judgment
 Epic of Gilgamesh blames Mars for the flood!

- (But) Enlil shall not come near to the offering, because without reflection he brought on the deluge and consigned my people to destruction! As soon as Enlil arrived and saw the ship, Enlil was wroth!

The Planet Mars

 Talmudic literature and the Apocrypha both list 7 Archangels – The Talmud assigns these to the 7 planets as 'guardians'

Sun, Moon, Mercury, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Venus
 'Sammael' was assigned Mars

- 'Sammael' was believed to be Satan!

The Planet Mars

Most ancient cultures worshipped Mars
Believed to be Baal of the Old Testament 2 Kings 23:5 et al

Romans had two days set aside to honour Mars
 Tubulustrium – day of trouble, turmoil, tumult – March 20/21
 Armilustrium – day of alarm – October 24

Tubulustrium – coincides with the Passover – March 20/21
 Armilustrium – coincides with Noah's flood – October 24

Romulus founded Rome 750 B.C. about 15 miles upstream of the river Tiber! – Why?
Ancient Troy rebuilt 7 times – Why?

The Mars Scenario

- Biblical support?
- In the Old Testament, catastrophes are not only a repeating scenario; they are periodic.
- Usually they are reported to involve earthquakes, cosmic lightning, thunderous cosmic noise, volcanism and celestial flyby scenery.
- Four times in Hebrew records, the night of March 20-21 involved an angel from the heavens bringing fire, celestial noise, earthquakes, lightning and sudden destruction

- 200ft tides (Tsunamis)
- Land tides (+Polar shifts)
- It would cause meteor and bolide showers 30k/mph
- Lengthen the day by changing the precession
 Legend of a 'long night' in China (Vilako
 - -Could this by why March was named the 'lengthened month' – from where we get 'Lent' (pass-by in Mar 20th)
- Mars may have come within 35,000 miles of earth!
- The last pass-by occurred in 701 B.C. after which the orbits stabilised requiring 5 ¼ days to be added to our calendar

- The was the reason for the building of the Tower of Babel

• *"There were two reasons for the* prohibition of high-places; first, the danger of the old idolatry creeping back if the old localities were retained for worship; and, secondly, the danger to the unity of the nation if there should be more than one legitimate religious centre. The existence of the worship at high places did, in fact, facilitate the division of the kingdom."

⁵ And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. ⁶ And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. ⁷ Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

Building without God = confusion Building with God = harmony (Acts 2)

- "Cush is generally represented as having been a ringleader in the great apostasy...
- Cush as the son of Ham, was Her-mes or Mercury; for Hermes is just an Egyptian synonym for the "son of Ham".
- Now, Hermes was the great original prophet of idolatry; for he was recognised by the pagans as the author of their religious rites."

– Rev Alexander Hislop

- "Hyginus shows that he [Cush] was known as the grand agent in that movement which produced the division of tongues
- "For many ages, men lived under the government of Jove, without cities and laws, and all speaking one language. But after that, Mercury interpreted the speeches of men (whence an interpreter is called Hermeneuties), the same individual distributed the nations then discord began.
 - Rev Alexander Hislop

- "Mercury, then, or Hermes, or Cush, "the son of Ham", was the "divider of the speeches of men". He, it would seem, had been the ringleader in the scheme for building the great city and Tower of Babel"
 - Rev Alexander Hislop

• "...Bel signified "the confounder". ...And to this meaning of the name of the Babylonian Bel, there is a very distinct illusion in Jeremiah 1:2, where it is said "Bel is confounded", that is, "the confounder is brought to confusion".

- "That Cush was known to pagan antiquity under the very character of Bel, "the confounder", a statement of Ovid very clearly proves: "the ancients... called me Chaos". Now, first this dicisively shows that Chaos was known not merely as a state of confusion, but as the "god of confusion". ... Chaos is just one of the establised forms of the name of Chus or Cush"

- Cush aka Vulcan, cf Vulcan's hammer
 - How is the hammer of the whole earth, cut asunder and broken! - Jeremiah 51:23
- Cush aka Bel
 - Bel is confounded: Merodach is broken in pieces Jeremiah 50:2

- Re. Nimrod :
- "It is stated that is was by the command of a "certain king" that this ringleader in apostasy was put to death. Who could this king be, who was so determinedly opposed to the host of heaven?
- Who then, was most likely to head the opposition to the apostasy from the primitive worship? If Shem was at that time alive, as beyond question he was, who so likely as he?"

The Doom of Babylon

- Destruction of Babylon
 - "Never to be inhabited"
 - "Building materials never reused"
 - "Like Sodom and Gomorrah"
- Fall of Babylon
 - Without a battle
 - Became Alexander's capital
 - Atrophied over the centuries
 - Presently being rebuilt
- "Mystery Babylon?"

Revelation 17 & 18

- Note: one account (not two)
 - Some propose this is a duel judgment on a 'Spiritual Babylon' and 'Political Babylon'
- Theme Judgment of the Great Harlot
 - Chapter 17 will give us Her Description
 - Chapter 18 will give us Her Destruction
- Chapter breaks were not included until the 12th century

Identity of the Harlot

- The false religious system that has led people away from the worship of the true God, and symbolised as this woman, has been skilfully established by Satan since the time of the Tower of Babel
- With one purpose: to unite all mankind, thus reversing the effects of the Tower of Babel where God confused the languages of the people (Gen 11:7).

Identity of the Harlot

 Once mankind has been reunited again (through this false religious system) Satan will have no further uses for it and will then cause all mankind to worship him in the person of Antichrist. (See again Rev 13:3-4 / also Isaiah 14:14)

Identity of the City

- Babylon, not Rome
- Jeremiah 50, 51
- Isaiah 13, 14
- All deal with the destruction of literal Babylon
 - This has not taken place to date!
 - Babylon has been inhabited though the ages
 - Cyrus makes it his capitol, followed by Alexander the Great
