After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

Genesis 15:1

- If we do not know God as our shield, we don't understand our predicament!
- Abram now knows experientially that God is his Protector
 - He had just defeated 5 kings with his small army!

Our Predicament

- Our adversary seeks whom he may devour!
 - 1 Peter 5:8
- The Devil would sift us like wheat
 - Luke 22:31
- Also, we wrestle against spiritual wickedness
 - Ephesians 6:21
- …and against the flesh
 - which easily ensnares us Hebrews 12:1
 - And makes us think we can stand! 1 Cor 10:12

Our Shield & Defender

- Jesus 'ever liveth to make intercession' for us
 - Hebrews 7:25
- Jesus prayed: "keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are"
 - John 17:11

Our Shield & Defender

And Asa cried unto the LORD his God, and said, LORD, it is nothing with thee to help, whether with many, or with them that have no power: help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee, and in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou art our God; let not man prevail against thee.

13 I can do all things through Christ who strengths me

Philippians 4:13

13 Without me ye can do nothing.

Genesis 15:1

- We are to lay up our treasure in heaven...
- ...but have we considered that Jesus is our greatest reward?
- "I let go of all I have just to have all of You…"
- Perfect love casts out fear! 1 John 4:18

² And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus?

³ And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.

Genesis 15:2-3

 We have a surviving fragment of an ancient document by 'Nicolaus of Damascus' dating to c.20 B.C. citing 'Abram's' visit and stay in Damascus in between leaving Haran before arriving at Canaan

- ⁴ And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.
- And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.
- 6 And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

Abram's Faith

- We don't need faith to believe in God!
 - there is overwhelming evidence in creation and the Word!
- We need faith to believe God!
 - i.e. to believe in His promises by faith!
- This is given as an eternal example of faith
- This is also the first mention of God's Plan of redemption
- The promise of Genesis 3:15 now takes on substance

Justification by Faith

- 1 What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?
- ² For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God.
- For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Romans 4:1-3

Justification by Faith

⁵ He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? 6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. 7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. 8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed. 9 So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

Galatians 3:5-9

Justification by Faith

²³And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

James 2:23

⁷ And he said unto him, I am the LORD that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it. 8 And he said, Lord GOD, whereby shall I know that I shall inherit it? - And when the fowls came down upon the carcases, Abram drove them away.
- 12 And when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell upon him. 13 And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years; 14 And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.

Abram's Vision

- Abram's seed to be strangers in a foreign land
- They shall be servants
- They shall be afflicted Ex 1:8 'New king who knew not Joseph'
- The affliction will last 400 years Ex 12:40 'Sojourning 430y'
- God will judge the nation that afflicts them 10 plagues
- They will leave with great wealth Ex 12:35-36
- They will return to this land (Canaan) v16

- ¹⁵ And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age.
- ¹⁶ But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full.

Gen 15:15-16

"Iniquity of the Amorites not yet full"?

- They need to sin a bit more?
- God is giving them time to repent?
- The end of something is in sight:
 - the influx of the Nephilim would cease

17 And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. 18 In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates: 19 The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites, ²⁰ And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims, 21 And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites.



Unconditional Covenant

- Abram falls into a deep sleep
- God makes His declaration without Abram's participation
- Explained in Jeremiah 34:18-19
- God alone passes through the sacrifices
- 'barath' to cut a covenant



The Terms of the Covenant

- Declared eternal and unconditional
- Re-confirmed by an oath: Gen 22:15-18
- Confirmed to Isaac and to Jacob: Gen 26:2-5
 (despite their acts of disobedience);
- NT declares it immutable: Heb 6:13-18

The Promised Land

- The Boundaries are Unmistakeable
- "from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates"

Boundaries of the Land

 Abraham was promised the land between the river of Egypt and the Euphrates,

Gen 15:18-21; cf. Deut 11:24

- The full extent of the land promised was never possessed
 - For a brief period during the reigns of David and Solomon, Israel held the land from the Euphrates to the Gaza strip, or from Dan to Beersheba


1 Kings 4:24-25

- Nevertheless, the ideal of the promise was not lost sight of
 Ezek 47:15–20
- The promise to Abraham awaits fulfillment.

History of the Promised Land

- Abram will die in the Land
- His son Isaac will die in the Land
- His grandson Jacob will die in Egypt
- Then when the 400 years are complete...
- Moses will lead Israel out of Egypt
- Joshua will lead the Children of Israel into the Promised Land





1917 Balfour Declaration


 A short note from Britain's foreign secretary,

"His Majesty's Government view with favor the establishment in Palestine of a national home for the Jewish people."




1922 British Partition



United Nations Bias



- Of 865 Security Council resolutions passed before 1990:
 - 526 were directed against Israel 61%
- Of 690 General Assembly resolutions voted on before 1990:
 - 429 were directed against Israel. 62%
- During 5 wars against Israel
 - No UN resolutions against the Arab Nation

United Nations Bias



- November 2003 Israel introduced it's first resolution since 1976.
- Israel requested that Arab terrorist not target Israeli women and children.
- It was rejected.
- The UN then adopted a resolution that demanded protection of Palestinian children from Israel!

A Cup of Trembling

2 Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem.

One Third of all UN resolutions have to do with Israel (1:1000 of the worlds population)

Not Reckoned

8 How shall I curse, whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy, whom the LORD hath not defied?

Not Reckoned

"Israel has been a member of the United Nations for more than 50 years. Yet she is not allowed to take her 2 year term as one of the 10 rotating nations (joining the 5 permanent ones) on the UN security council. Of the 191 current members, 190, including the worst terrorist nations, are allowed to take their turns on the security council - but not Israel. Nor is Israel, as already noted, allowed to take a rotating turn on the 50-3-member UN commission on Human Rights.

Not Reckoned

All of the other 190 UN member nations are allowed to do so.

These have included Libya, Cuba, Zimbabwe, and other egregious violators of human rights. Incredibly, Sudan, where more than 2 million blacks in the south have been slaughtered by Muslims, has been voted in for a third consecutive term.

But Israel, the only demoracy in the Middle East, is excluded, as the Bible foretold".


