The Problem of the Natural

• "The wind was actually boisterous, the waves were actually high, but Peter did not see them at first. After Separating from Lot

¹ Now Sarai Abram's wife bare him no children: and she had an handmaid, an Egyptian, whose name was Hagar.

² And Sarai said unto Abram, Behold now, the LORD hath restrained me from bearing: I pray thee, go in unto my maid; it may be that I may obtain children by her. And Abram hearkened to the voice of Sarai.

Helping God?

- The temptation doesn't come screaming 'temptation' but common sense!
- "The good is the enemy of the best"

-Oswald Chambers

- Sarai's advice was practical and was according to Egyptian practice
 - Surrogate mothering common in Egypt
 - Moses will be "taken" as a son of Pharaoh's wife (Exodus 2)
- Abram doesn't want God's plan to be thwarted by his inability

Lessons in Grace

- ¹⁹ And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb:
- ²⁰ He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;
- ²¹ And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

³ And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.

⁴ And he went in unto Hagar, and she conceived: and when she saw that she had conceived, her mistress was despised in her eyes.

This didn't work out how Sarah had anticipated!

The Foundation of Failure

But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

James 1:14-15

We don't think through the consequences! Compromise in the Face of Anticipated Failure

⁵ And Sarai said unto Abram, My wrong be upon thee: I have given my maid into thy bosom; and when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes: the LORD judge between me and thee.
⁶ But Abram said unto Sarai, Behold, thy maid is in thy hand; do to her as it pleaseth thee. And when Sarai dealt hardly with her, she fled from her face.

The Angel of the LORD

- First occurrence in the Bible
- Literally "Messenger of YHWH"
- The Messenger speaks in First Person
 —"I will"
- This has to be the "Expressed Image of God"

The Angel of the LORD

God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds; who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person...

- Identified with Yahweh

- Yet distinct from YHWH

Gen. 24:7; 2 Sam. 24:16; Zech. 1:12

 May refer to a theophany of the preincarnate Christ

> Cf. Gen. 18:1-2; 19:1; Num. 22:22; Jud. 2:1-4; 5:23; Zech. 12:8

Hagar

- Hagar's name means "flight"
- She flees back toward Egypt
- She is pregnant with Abram's child
- "Way to Shur"
 - Hebrew word meaning "wall"
 - Fortified boarder of Egypt
- After asking Where, What and Why...
- God gives her His commandment.
 "Return & Submit."



The Promise

"I will multiply your descendants exceedingly, so that they shall not be counted for multitude."

Prophecy Concerning Ishmael

- Ishmael means "God hears"
- 5 Prophetic Attributes:

Prophecy Concerning Ishmael

- 1. "I will multiply your descendants exceedingly, so that they shall not be counted for multitude."
 - Ishmael becomes the father of 12 tribes
 - Listed in Genesis 25:12-16
 - Occupy most of the Middle Eastern Region
- Destiny of these Descendants

- "They dwelt from Havilah as far as Shur, which is east of Egypt as you go toward Assyria" (Gen 25:18)

- Havilah = Arabia
- Shur = Eastern Boarder of Egypt

- Nebajoth = "Fruitfulness"
- Kedar = "Darkness"
- Adbeel
- Mibsam
- Mishma
- Dumah

- = "Chastened of God"
- = "Sweet odour"
- = "Hearing"
- = "Silence"
- 2. "He shall be a wild man;"
 - "wild" = Literally "wild ass"
 - Meaning, "an untamable animal"

- 3. "His hand shall be against every man,"
 - Arabian Legacy of Tribal War
 - T.E. Lawrence (Lawrence of Arabia)
 - Objective:

"Unify the feuding Arab tribes against the Turks."

- 4. "And every man's hand against him."
 - The Domination of the Arabs
 - Conquered by the:
 - Egyptians, Babylonians, Persians
 - Greek Empire, Roman Empire
 - European Crusaders
 - Mongolian Empire, Ottoman Empire
 - British Empire

- 5. "And he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren."
 - The Attribute of Conflict (wild ass man) will be with ALL of his brethren.
 - They will dwell "in the presence" of the Children of Israel.

Abraham 430 years before the Law
 Promises preceded the Law: cannot be
 disannulled

Galatians 3:17

- Ishmael vs Isaac
 - Two sons of two principles: Flesh; Spirit
 - Ishmael: of the flesh, in unbelief
 - "The son of the bondwoman will not be heir..."
 - Isaac: of promise, in response to faith
 - The Ultimate Triumph of Faith: the offering of Isaac

¹² And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which is not of thy seed.

Genesis 17:11-12

¹³ He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.

¹⁴ And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.

Genesis 17:13-14

Circumcision

- Vitamin K, clotting element, not formed until the 5th to the 7th day
- Prothrombin, also necessary
 - 3rd day: 30% of normal
 - –8th day: peaks at 110%, then levels off at 100% of normal
- How did Moses know to circumcise on the 8th day? Gen 17:1

Papyrus Ebers 1332 BC

- Embedded splinter?
 - Apply worm's blood & ass's dung.
- Loosing Hair?
 - Apply 6 fats
 - Horse, Hippopotamus, Crocodile, Cat, Snake, Ibex
- Turning Gray?

 Anoint with blood of black calf which has been boiled in oil or fat of rattlesnake

Papyrus Ebers 1332 BC

The well-stocked medicine cabinet:

- Lizard's blood
- Swine's teeth
- Putrid meat
- Moisture from pig's ears
- Milk goose grease
- Asses' hooves
- Animal fats
- Excreta from animals
 - Human, Donkeys, Antelopes, Dogs, Cats, Flies

Circumcision of the Heart

Moses:

 God would "circumcise the hearts" of His people so that they might be devoted to Him Deut. 30:6

Unbelief:

- having an uncircumcised heart

Jer. 9:26; Ez. 44:7-9

• Paul:

 - "circumcision of the heart" evidences salvation and fellowship with God

Rom 2:28-29; 4:11

¹⁶ And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall her name be.
¹⁶ And I will bless her, and give thee a son also of her: yea, I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of people shall be of her.

 - 1. Covenant to Abraham's physical seed
- 2. Land defined: Euphrates to Nile Genesis 17
 - 1. Covenant with physical seed, forever
 - 2. Land of Canaan everlasting possession





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
