Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb... Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year... And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole congregation of Israel shall kill is [between the

evenings]\* The Hebrew word is 'Beyn' which means 'between'

This is another evidence of the supernatural design of the Bible. Just as in this model, laid down some f600 years before, Jesus was taken' on the 10th, and as a Lamb without blemish, was killed on the 14th between the evenings, shedding His own blood to become our Passover Lamb, atoning for our sin once and for all.

Truly He is the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world! (John 1:29)

### 10th Begins John 12:1-2

Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

There they made him a supper (i.e an evening meal)

NB: 'Passover' here is used to denote the 'festival' period commencing the 15th, not the supper on the 14th. It is also used this way in John 13:1 So after 6 days is the 15th & the teast.





## **Topology of Mount Moriah**




Peak: Akedah




