



# The Feast of Harvest a.k.a. Pentecost

1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come...

Acts 2:1

"The words 'fully come' could be translated "fulfilled." When the Day of Pentecost was being fulfilled, they were all together in one place". J Vernon McGee

15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

16 Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

**Leviticus 23:15-22** 

- The first instruction was that a <u>new</u> הואלים היים היים היים וואר היים וואר היים וואר היים וואר היים וואר היים היים וואר ה
  - translated 'meat' in the KJV
  - It was a sacrificial offering, usually bloodless and voluntary
- This Feast therefore speaks of something new that was to be voluntarily presented to the LORD.

Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

**Leviticus 23:15-22** 

- That which was to be presented was to come out of the houses of Israel
- From whence came the Church?

17 Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

**Leviticus 23:15-22** 

- Two: The number of witness
- Double offering?
- Double fulfilment?

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**Leviticus 23:15-22** 

 Fine Flour: carefully ground and sifted to remove all impurities, bran and husks

#### Fine Flour

- Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;
- That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,
- That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

  Ephesians 5:25-27

- This is the <u>only</u> Feast where leaven is to be used
- Leaven speaks of sin
  - Because it corrupts by puffing up (1 Cor 5:8)
- Whereas Israel were to be separate from the world - 'uncontaminated'
- The Church is to grow to maturity...

...in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world

- Finis Jennings Dake comments:
- "No bread made with leaven could be burned upon the alter (Lev 2:11), so the object was not a burnt offering; this was a present to Jehovah from the best produce of the earth".
- The Church is not destined to be consumed on the altar of God's wrath, but instead is a gift from the Father to His Son of those He (the Father) draws out of the world (cf. John 6:44).

#### **Firstfruits**

18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

**James 1:18** 

And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work therein: It shall be a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.

**Leviticus 23:15-22** 

- When a person is born again they enter into their eternal rest in Christ;
- No longer are they to labour by their own efforts for reward, for Christ has done it all.
- The writer to the Hebrews comments:

... For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his

#### Sabbath Days

Israel had 70 Sabbaths according to the Law of Moses

- 52 weekly Sabbaths
- 7 days for Passover
- 1 day for the Feast of Pentecost
- 1 day for the Feast of Trumpets
- 1 day for the Feast of Atonement
- 7 days for the Feast of Tabernacles
- 1 day for the 'Eighth day of Assembly'

#### 8th Day of Assembly

- Last day: 'Great day of the Feast'
- Feast of Tabernacles = 7 days + 8<sup>th</sup> day
- Feast was to specifically remember their wilderness wanderings
- During the Feast, they would pour water out in memory of the water from the rock at Horeb

#### Water from the Rock

The people cried out for water

- And the LORD said unto Moses, Go on before the people, and take with thee of the elders of Israel; and thy rod, wherewith thou smotest the river, take in thine hand, and go.
- <sup>6</sup> Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

**Exodus 17:5-6** 

#### Water from the Rock

- This is God's object lesson on Rest
- The specific Rock is identified by God
- God tells Moses, "I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb"
- Moses is told, "you shall strike the rock"
- What do we know about THIS rock?

#### Water from the Rock

The Split Rock

He split the rock in the wilderness,

And gave them drink in abundance like the depths.

He also brought streams out of the rock,

And caused waters to run down like rivers.

#### Water from the Rock

The Rock has a Name

Moreover, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware that all our fathers were under the cloud, all passed through the sea, all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.

#### Object Lesson on Rest

- God says, "I will stand before you there on the rock in Horeb"
  - Rock in Horeb (desert) = Jesus Christ
  - God stands on the Rock = Jesus is the only foundation for Rest
- "Go on before the people"
  - This will be done before all of the people

#### Object Lesson on Rest

- "take with you some of the elders of Israel"
  - Elders of Israel will be key witnesses
- "take in your hand your rod"
  - Moses is a symbol of the Law
  - His rod is a symbol of the Authority of the Law
- "you shall strike the rock"
  - The Authority of the Law strikes the Rock





#### **Future Failure of Moses**

- Numbers 20
- While camped at Kadesh
- Moses will be told to "speak to the rock" (20:8)
- In anger he strikes the rock (20:11)
- Moses is told he will not enter the Promised Land (20:24)

#### The Last Day of The Feast

- Water drawn from the pool of Siloam throughout the Feast – poured out on the alter
- The last day water not drawn to indicate their thirst was not yet satisfied, i.e Messiah was not yet come
- They would read from Isaiah 12

### Living Water

- Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.
- <sup>4</sup> And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.
- <sup>5</sup> Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this is known in all the earth.
- <sup>6</sup> Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

Isaiah 12:3-6

- In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.
- 38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

# The Appointed Times

and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

Genesis 1:14b

MYC Mh Ha Moyadim – 'the appointed times'

Statistical expectation: 5 times in the 78,064 letters of Genesis;

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- It is centered on Genesis 1:14.
- Odds against this by unaided chance have been estimated at greater than 70,000,000 to one!

#### The Feasts of Israel

- Passover
  - 14<sup>th</sup> Nisan
- Feast of Unleavened Bread
  - 15<sup>th</sup> Nisan
- Feast of Firstfruits
  - the day after the Sabbath after Passover
  - always on a Sunday

#### The Feast of Passover

(Summary)

- Take a lamb on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month
   (March/April)
- The lamb must be perfect
- On the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month they were to kill the lamb in the evening
- The blood of the lamb was to be put on the doorposts & lintel – all who passed 'under the blood' into the house would be safe from God's judgment upon the firstborn of the land

# 7 days of unleavened bread



#### The Feast of Firstfruits

- 10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:
- And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

**Leviticus 23:10-11** 



# 2. Jesus said He would rise from the dead

### The Hour Is Come!

- <sup>23</sup> And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified.

## Palm Sunday

- For the first time in His ministry, Jesus allows Himself to be worshipped and hailed as the King, the Messiah
- Jesus not only allows it, He arranges the whole event!
- This was not just any day
- It was the specific day (prophesied by Gabriel and recorded by Daniel 500+ years earlier) when the Messiah would come



# The Triumphal Entry

On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. 14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, 15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

John 12:12-15

- 41 And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,
- 42 Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.
- 43 For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,
- And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.


And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

#### The Interval

- After the 483 years
- But before the final 7 years
- Messiah is to be cut off
- The city of Jerusalem is to be destroyed
- Until the 'end' desolations will continue
- A 'prince' will come who will be of those who destroy the city
- A prince will come from 'Rome'

- 483 years x 360 days per year
- Prophetic years always reckoned as 360 days in Scripture


# 360 day Prophetic Years

- Dan 7:25, 12:7 inferred cf Rev 12:6, 12:14, 13:5-7 1260d
- Rev 11:2, 11:3, 13:5, 12:6 42 mts, 1260d
- Servitude of Nation, 606 B.C. 537 B.C.
   70yrs @ 360d per yr
- Desolations of Jerusalem, 587 B.C. 518 B.C.
   70yrs @ 360d per yr
- Ezekiel 4, 430yrs 70 = 360yrs x 7 (cf Lev 28) = 2520yrs @ 360d
   Servitude: 537 B.C. 14/5/1948
   Desolations: 518 B.C. 7/06/1967
- Daniel 9:27, Jeremiah's Prophecies + Final week = 2520d
- Daniel 9:24-27, Exactly 360 letters in 4 verses (Hebrew)

# 360 Day Year?

- Ancient calendars based on 360 day years
  - Assyrians, Chaldeans, Egyptians, Hebrews, Persians, Greeks, Phoenicians, Chinese, Mayans, Hindus, Carthaginians, Etruscans, Teutons, et al.
- 360° in a circle, 60 minutes/hour, 60 sec/min
- 360 icons in the gnostic genii
- 360 gods in theology of Greek Orpheus
- 360 idols in the palace of Dairi in Japan
- 360 statues surrounding Hobal in Arabia





# The Feast of Passover

- <sup>5</sup> Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:
- 6 And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.
- And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb... Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year... And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole congregation of Israel shall kill is [between the

evenings]\* The Hebrew word is 'Beyn' which means 'between'

This is another evidence of the supernatural design of the Bible. Just as in this model, laid down some f600 years before, Jesus was taken' on the 10th, and as a Lamb without blemish, was killed on the 14th between the evenings, shedding His own blood to become our Passover Lamb, atoning for our sin once and for all.

Truly He is the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world! (John 1:29)







### **Topology of Mount Moriah**





## The Royal Guard

- This "watch", was a royal roman guard made up of 16 highly trained roman soldiers
- Each would have a spear, a short sword, and a dagger,
- Each man also had 5 javelins inside of a curved shield
- Their primary weapon however was a sling
- They were trained to hit a target 70 ft. away
- They were the special forces of their day

# The Royal Guard

- And if a commanding officer came and found just one of those guards asleep all 16 men in the guard would be killed
- So if one fell asleep the other guards would set their tunic on fire!
- In 390 A.D. as Rome was beginning to fall apart, the then Caesar commanded Flavius Viratus Ronitus (historian) to search the archives for military and tactical inspiration
- As a result he reconstructed this elite unit

# The Royal Guard

- The tomb was sealed either with wax/clay
- Ropes would have been put across the stone, with the seal or Rome in the centre
- If anyone broke the seal, the punishment was to be crucified upside down,
- If they couldn't catch you, they would crucify upside down every man, woman and child in your village,
- That tomb was sealed and secure!

- In Israel there were tax collectors who would stay in their office and do the paperwork...
- And others who would go out and about and collect taxes from the public
- Matthew was the latter, called 'publicans'
  - Because they collected from the public,
- As a servant of Rome he would always have had a roman soldier with him
  - With his shield and his spear to signify the authority of Rome,

# The Inside Story!

- Matthew is the only Gospel writer to tell us what happened at the tomb...
- ...that an angel came down, and rolled the stone away,
- ...and what happened in the discussion with Pilate...
- ...and that the soldiers didn't go to Pilate when they fled the tomb, but to the priests,
- ...and that the priests paid the soldiers to keep quiet!

- Now when they were going, behold, some of the watch came into the city, and shewed unto the chief priests all the things that were done.
- And when they were assembled with the elders, and had taken counsel, they gave large money unto the soldiers,
- Saying, Say ye, His disciples came by night, and stole him away while we slept.

- It is Pilate's report to Emperor Caesar concerning the events of the crucifixion and alleged resurrection of Jesus
- He details:
  - What happened regarding the crucifixion
  - The kind of man Jesus was
  - That Jesus had been granted freedom to teach the people
  - That wealthy people didn't like Jesus on account of his support for the poor

- It is Pilate's report to Emperor Caesar concerning the events of the crucifixion and alleged resurrection of Jesus
- He details:
  - Miraculous events at the tomb of Jesus
    - That a brilliant light was seen
    - That an angelic being appeared
    - That there was an earthquake
    - That trained Roman guards collapsed in terror
    - And that they actually saw Jesus risen from the dead
    - But that they were then given money to keep quiet

Justin Martyr, in his first apology for the Christians, which was presented to the Emperor Antoninus Pius, in the year A. D., 138, having mentioned the Crucifixion of Jesus and some of its attendant circumstances, says:

"And that these things were so done, you may know from the Acts made in the time of Pontius Pilate."

The learned Tertullian, in his Apology for Christianity, about the year 200, after speaking of our Savior's crucifixion and resurrection, and his appearance to the disciples, who were ordained by him to publish the Gospel over the world, thus proceeds:

"Of all these things relating to Christ, Pilate himself, in his conscience already a Christian, sent an account to Tiberius, then Emperor."
