
What is Dark Energy?

The Big Bang theory of the creation of the Universe originally predicted that its expansion would slow down, and that it would possibly begin to contract as a result of the pull of gravity

However, in 1998, astronomers were shocked to discover that not only was the Universe continuing to expand, but that this expansion was also accelerating.

Apologetics

- Apologetics is a Greek term from two root words meaning to 'speak away'
- Plato, in his famous book Apology recorded the defence of Socrates to the charges laid against him in 399 B.C.
- The term thereafter was given to any speech made by a defendant
- Apologetics has come to mean any reasoned and structured response to critics, detractors, antagonists or sceptics

Apologetics

- From a Christian perspective:
- The "marshalling together evidence into a structure that will demonstrate in a clear, forceful yet sensitive way the credibility and reasonableness of the Christian faith"
- Pastor Barry Definition:
 - "The art of causing people to think!"
 - People don't reject Christianity because of the lack of evidence, but because they have been led to believe that no evidence exists!
 People equate 'belief' with emotion, not facts

- 1) Cosmological
- The world & universe must have had an origin and cause
- Nothing cannot create everything!
 Even if you give it billions of years!!
- But matter could not have been around for ever either!
 - If it had been it would have all entropied by now
 - There would be no more available energy and everything in the universe would be at a uniform temperature

- 2) Teleological
- We can observe design in nature – DNA / symmetry / complexity / diversity etc.
- If there is design, there must be a Designer who is outside of creation itself
 - Building = Builder
 - Painting = Painter
 - Creation = Creator

3) Moral Argument

- Man has an inbuilt sense of right and wrong
- These are non-physical attributes so cannot be the product of chemical or biological evolution
 - Love / Hatred / Justice / Righteousness etc.
- Our sense of morality must have come from a moral Creator

- 4) Anthropological Argument
- Man has an inbuilt sense of a 'higher power'
- In all cultures throughout all time there is some form of belief in God or gods
 - Man is prone to cry out to that which is outside himself both in regard to worship and also 'salvation'
- If we have this inbuilt capacity for 'God', Deity must exist in some form or another

5) Ontological Argument

- If we can conceive of a infinite or perfect being, yet we recognise we ourselves are imperfect and finite...
- The idea of an infinite being must have come from 'Him' rather than us






"For 45 years continuously I have devoted myself to one great study of the Old Testament. In all of its languages, in all of its archaeology, in all of its translations.




"After I learned the necessary languages, I set about the investigation of every singe consonant in the Hebrew Old Testament – there are about one million, two hundred and fifty thousand of them.


It took me many years to achieve my task. I had to observe variations in the text, in the manuscripts, notes of the masorites in all their various versions, parallel passages, and contextual emendations of critics; and then I had to classify the results of every character, every consonant, to reduce the Old Testament criticism to an absolutely objective science, something that is based on evidence and not opinion.



The result of those 45 years of study which I have given to the text has been this:




"I can affirm that there is not a page of the Old Testament concerning which you need have any doubt!"



"For example, to illustrate its accuracy: there are 29 ancient kings whose names are mentioned, not only in the Bible, but also on monuments we've uncovered of their own time.


There are 195 consonants in those 29 proper names. Yet we find that in the documents of the Hebrew Old Testament there are only two consonants out of the 195 that have ever been called into question."




"[The names] are all in exactly the same way as they have been inscribed on their monuments which archaeologists have dated and discovered. Some of these go back four thousand years.

Compare this accuracy with the greatest scholar of his age, the librarian at Alexandria in Egypt, (200 B.C.) He complied a catalogue of the kings of Egypt, 38 in all. Of the entire number only three or four were recognisable.

He also made a list of the kings of Assyria and in only one case can we tell who he's talking about - and that one is not spelt correctly!




"Or take Ptolemy who drew up a register of eighteen kings of Babylon; not one of them is properly spelt. You could not make them out at all if you did not know some of the outside sources."




"If anyone talks about the Bible, ask him about the kings mentioned in it. There are 29 kings referred to, 10 different countries among these 29, all of which are included in the Bible and on the monuments.

Every one of these is give their right name in the Bible, their right country and their right place in correct chronological order.



 In other words, we were solemnly assured in the light of modern wisdom that, historically speaking, the book of Genesis was simply not worth the paper it was written on.


On the one hand I had the Bible itself claiming to be the very Word of God, and on the other I was presented with numerous commentaries that spoke with one voice in telling me that the Bible was nothing of the kind. It was merely a hotch-potch collection of middle-eastern myths and fables that sought to explain the world in primitive terms.

Now, it simply was not possible for both these claims to be valid. Only one of them could be right...



So it was then that I decided to select a certain portion of Genesis and submit it to a test which, if applied to any ordinary historical document, would be considered a test of the most unreasonable severity. And I would continue that test until either the book of Genesis revealed itself to be a false account, or it would be shown to be utterly reliable in its historical statements.


What I had not expected at the time was the fact that the task was to engage my attention and energies for more than twenty-five years...



The test that I devised was a simple one. If the names of the individuals, families, peoples and tribes listed in the Table of Nations were genuine, then those same names should appear also in the records of other nations of the Middle East.


It simply was not realistic to expect that every name would have been recorded in the annals of the ancient Middle East and would also have survived to the present day.

I therefore would have been content to have found say 40% of the list vindicated.




In fact that would have been a very high achievement given the sheer antiquity of the Table of Nations itself and the reported scarcity of the surviving extra-biblical records from those ancient times.

But when, over my twenty-five years of research, that confirmatory evidence grew past 40% to 50%, and then 60% and beyond, it soon became apparent that modern wisdom in this matter was wide of the mark. Very wide of the mark indeed.




Today I can say that the names so far vindicated in the Table of Nations make up over 99% of the list,

...and I shall make no further comment on that other than to say that no other ancient historical document of purely human authorship could be expected to yield such a level of corroboration as that!



Matthew Fontaine Maury

- Matthew Fontaine Maury was born in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, in 1806.
- As an avid Bible reader, he was struck by a reference to "the paths of the seas" Psalm 8
- He also noticed that Isaiah wrote of a "path through the mighty waters" Isaiah 43:16
- Are there pathways in the seas? Who could imagine such a thing? The pursuit of this enigma became Maury's lifetime quest.

Matthew Fontaine Maury

- He entered the Navy in 1825 as a midshipman.
- By 1842 he was placed in charge of the Depot of Charts and Instruments, out of which grew the U.S. Naval Observatory and Hydrographic Office.
- To gather information on maritime winds and currents, Maury distributed to ship captains specially prepared logbooks from which he compiled pilot charts, enabling him to shorten the time of sea voyages.



Matthew Fontaine Maury

- In 1848 he published maps of the main wind fields of the Earth.
 - Maury was ultimately able to produce charts of the Atlantic, Pacific, and Indian Oceans, a profile of the Atlantic seabed, and the first modern oceanographic text.
- He is internationally recognized as the "Father of Oceanography,"
 - Maury Hall at the U.S. Naval Academy is named in his honor.
- All because of a *remez*, a hint of something deeper, in a verse in the Psalms.


The Mazaroth

- The Talmud lists more than a dozen rules for copying the Torah
- Built-in security system!
- If even just one of these factors is lacking, it does not possess the sanctity of a Torah scroll, and is not to be used for a public Torah reading.
- The meticulous process of hand-copying a scroll takes about 2,000 hours (a full-time job for one year).
- Throughout the centuries, Jewish scribes have adhered to the following guidelines:

- 1. The parchment must be made from the skin of a clean animal (clean meaning ceremonially clean according to the Old Testament sanitary laws); must be prepared by a Jew only, and the skins must be fastened together by strings taken from clean animals.
- 2. Each column must have no less than forty-eight, nor more than sixty lines.
- 3. The entire copy must be first lined.

- 4. A Torah Scroll is disqualified if even a single letter is added.
- 5. A Torah Scroll is disqualified if even a single letter is deleted.
- 6. The scribe must be a learned, pious Jew, who has undergone special training and certification.
- 7. All materials (parchment, ink, quill) must conform to strict specifications, and be prepared specifically for the purpose of writing a Torah Scroll.

- 8. The scribe may not write even one letter into a Torah Scroll from memory. Rather, he must have a second, kosher scroll opened before him at all times.
- 9. The scribe must pronounce every word out loud before copying it from the correct text.
- 10.Every letter must have sufficient white space surrounding it. If one letter touched another in any spot, it invalidates the entire scroll.

- 11. If a single letter was so marred that it cannot be read at all, or resembles another letter (whether the defect is in the writing, or is due to a hole, tear or smudge), this invalidates the entire scroll.
- 12. Each letter must be sufficiently legible so that even an ordinary schoolchild could distinguish it from other, similar letters.
- 13. The scribe must put precise space between words, so that one word will not look like two words, or two words look like one word.

- 14. The scribe must not alter the design of the sections, and must conform to particular line-lengths and paragraph configurations.
- 15. The ink must be of no other colour than black, and it must be prepared according to a special recipe.
- 16. He must reverently wipe his pen each time before writing the word for "God" (Elohim), and he must wash his whole body before writing the name "Jehovah" (LORD in KJV), lest the Holy Name be contaminated.

- 17. Each Hebrew letter has a numerical value; each column when completed must be added up and be the exact numerical value as the scroll you were copying from.
- 18. Each page must also add up numerically
- 19. The revision (to correct any errors) of a roll must be made within thirty days after the work was finished; otherwise it was worthless.
- 20. One mistake on a sheet condemned the entire sheet. If three mistakes were found on any page, the entire manuscript was condemned.

"The fact is, that after all the trials and tribulations, communal dislocations and persecutions, only the Yemenite Torah scrolls contain any difference from the rest of world Jewry. For hundreds of years, the Yemenite community was not part of the global checking system, and a total of nine letter-differences are found in their scrolls.

These are all spelling differences. In no case do they change the meaning of the word."

• What have they told us? Discovered between 1947 and 1956 - In caves in Qumran in southern Israel They comprise some 800 documents ...dating from around 250 BC to 68 AD Among the Scrolls are partial or complete copies of every book in the **Hebrew Bible**

- except the book of Esther

The caves at Qumran are famous for the hoard of Old Testament and other manuscripts that have been found there. But the thing which receives the least publicity (if any publicity at all) is the fact that the caves have also yielded fragments of New Testament books. This absence of publicity – this blanket denial of their identity – is not to be wondered at.

It was really most awkward. In fact, it still is very awkward for them, for it means that the fragments must have been written out – copied from even earlier exemplars – well before A.D. 68, which undermines everything that the critics have been claiming all these years.
